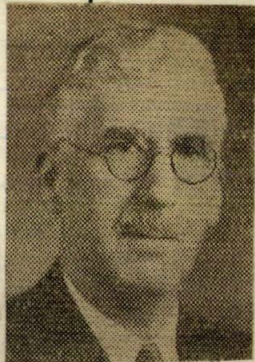

Lisbon Falls, Nov. 1—Charles R. Dickinson died at his home on Addison Street Monday night after a long illness.

He was born in Billview, N. J., Dec. 9, 1865, son of Samuel and Bedelia MacDonald Dickinson. He came to Maine in 1891 from Niagara Falls, and was employed at the Pejepscot Paper Company for 47 years of which he was superintendent for 33 years, retiring in 1938.

He is survived by his widow, two brothers, William of Sandy Creek, N. Y., and Samuel of Lisbon Falls, two sisters, Mrs. Harry Atwood and Mrs. Alvin Kierstead of Wiscasset.

Mr. Dickinson was a 32nd degree Mason, a member of the Odd Fellows, and B. P. O. E., of Lewiston, and Knights of Pythias.

Funeral services were held Thursday afternoon from his home, in the charge of Rev. Robert I. Sweetser.

The honorary bearers were, Walter Plummer, Harry Wright, Dr. A. W. Plummer and W. W. Nearing of Brunswick; active bearers were Edgar Catlin, R. E. Commee, Worthington Brawn, S. S. Young, Fenton Tobie, and Phillip Adams. Burial was at Hillside Cemetery.

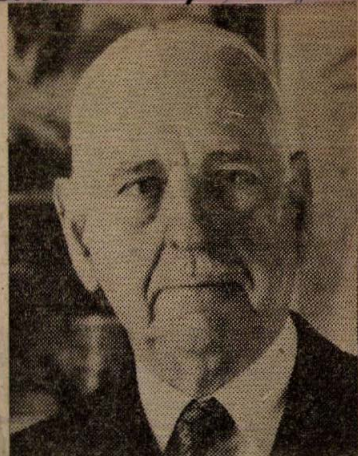

ROSELLE PARK, March 8. — Former Mayor Elliott C. Dill was honored last night by Wheatsheaf Lodge 272, F. & A. M. in behalf of the Grand Lodge of Masons of the State of Maine in recognition of his fifty years of service as a Mason. His son, School Commissioner Elliott C. Dill, Jr. presented him with a fifty-year emblem in behalf of the Grand Lodge of Maine and many Masonic dignitaries extended congratulations.

Worshipful Master Yorke E. Rhodes conducted the presentation session. Past master B. R. Barrowcliff, presented a history of fifty-year presentations by the grand lodges of New Jersey and Maine, after which the golden anniversary honors were conferred upon Mr. Dill. In making the presentation, his son outlined the long line of Masonic achievement in the Dill family extending back to 1851, when former Mayor Dill's grandfather, Seward Dill was raised in Blue Mountain Lodge 67, of Phillips, Me., and became its first candidate to be initiated. The latter served in several lodge offices and became a fifty-year mason. His son, Harry P. Dill, father of the former mayor here, was raised in Blue Mountain Lodge in 1866, likewise served in numerous Masonic capacities and also became a fifty-year Mason. The latter was secretary in 1871 and, as historian in 1872, printed an interesting history of the lodge.

Former Mayor Dill demitted in 1899 to Tranquil Lodge 29, F. & A. M. of Auburn, Me., and has continued to be a member of that lodge. He was elected a life member of it last month. He has been a member of Bradford Chapter 38, R. A. M. of Auburn since May 2, 1899, and has been a member of Alpha Council, Hallowell, Me., and of Lewiston Commandary 6, many years.

Mr. Dill was born in Phillips, Me., December 30, 1874. He has lived in Roselle Park thirty-one years. At 18 he engaged in newspaper work, served on various papers in Maine and became a Spanish-American war correspondent in 1898. He joined the Maine National Guard in 1900, became adjutant in 1909 and served until 1913. He was active in both world wars, in the last one as chairman of the Roselle Park Civilian Defense Council. His private business interests until his retirement about a year ago were in the National Lead Company which he served as co-ordinator of purchases. He was the borough's mayor in 1919 and 1920, served six years as president of the Central Union Boy Scout Council, which covered a number of Union County communities, and served on the local Board of Education of which he became president. Mr. Dill was a vestryman in St. Luke's Episcopal Church many years and subsequently became senior warden of the Roselle church. He is president of the Sporting Arms Manufacturers Institute of America.

Among the 200 guests attending the presentation was Francis P. Dill, of Worcester, Mass., son of the honored guest. The former is a member of Morning Star Lodge of Worcester. Among letters of congratulations received were tributes from Col. Lester M. Hart, assistant adjutant general of Maine, and Ralph W. Crockett, both thirty-third degree masons. Among those to congratulate Mr. Dill personally and pay him tribute were Mayor Bernard H. Dreifoos and Edward C. Moffitt, borough treasurer. Roselle.
