John R. Dimock, 81, youngest member of the Bosworth Post, G. A. R., died Tuesday in the U. S. Marine Hospital after two months illness.

Mr. Dimock was born at Nova Scotia, son of William P. and Hannah Reading Dimock, and came to Portland when a child. He served as a wardroom boy in the Navy during the Civil War aboard the frigate Hartford, Admiral Farragut's flagship. After the war he made a voyage to Japan and China in the Hartford, and upon his return to Portland was discharged from the Navy. He followed the sea several years and then became a brakeman on the old Eastern Railroad, which later became part of the Boston and Maine.

About 35 years ago he entered the Customs Service as boatman and later served as storekeeper, retiring when he became 70 years old. He was commander of the Bosworth Post three years ago. He was also a Mason and an Odd Fellow.

Mr. Dimock is survived by a sister, Mrs. Ella Van Blarcom, and a niece, Mrs. Doris Haley of Portland.

Raymond, July 10—Harry P. Dingley, 59, local farmer and former traveling salesman for the A. H. Bailey Confectionery Company of Portland 20 years, died Wednesday in his home.

—Harry Augustus Dinsmore, 86, for years prominent in Masonic and Odd Fellows in Maine and for over 50 years engaged in music and insurance businesses, died this morning in the Odd Fellows Home at Auburn.

He went to the Auburn home in the Fall of 1940.

The Rev. Earle M. Hamilton, pastor of the Methodist Church, will officiate at funeral services at the Lord funeral home, Skowhegan, at 2 p. m. Sunday. Interment will be in the family lot here.

Born in Skowhegan, Dec. 1, 1856, he attended Skowhegan schools and Maine Wesleyan Seminary at Kent's Hill, from which he was graduated in 1877. Being unable to attend graduation exercises, he did not receive his diploma until 1933.

On Jan. 1, 1886, he and his uncle, Samuel A. Bickford formed the Dinsmore and Bickford insurance firm here and he had always continued his business under that name.

He continued operation of his music store here for 39 years until 1924.

Mr. Dinsmore wrote and published more than 20 songs, the most famous of which was Sunrise With The Master, more suitable for church use.

He became a member of the Methodist Church in 1877 and for many years served as secretary and in other church offices.

Long associated with the Masons and Odd Fellows, he was occupant of all chairs in local lodges, was a past grand commander of the Grand Council, R&SM, a 32nd Degree Mason and member of all its bodies.

In the Grange, he held membership in Skowhegan, Somerset Pomona, the State and National bodies.

He was also a member of the Three-Quarter Century Club.

In 1936, Mr. Dinsmore was presented a 50-year gold medal from one of the companies he represented

and an electric clock by another for 50 years of continuous service.


