BINGHAM — Capt. Douglas Pope Dolan, 69, of Bingham, died Monday, Aug. 23, 1999, at his Owens Street home following a long, courageous battle with cancer.

He was born June 5, 1930, in Hollywood, Calif., son of Capt. William E. and Abigail H. (Pope) Dolan. His family moved to Maine and then back to California, living in Los Angeles and San Francisco. They returned to New England, where they purchased a home in Dummerston, Vt. They later moved to Maine and lived in Moxie Township and Solon. He attended The Forks and Solon schools, and Thomas College in Waterville, studying real estate.

As a young boy, Doug delivered newspapers in the town of Solon, serving customers from one end of town to the other. He was employed for a time at Solon Manufacturing and as a trucker loading his truck by hand. He had been employed as a land surveyor and at various jobs at Quimby Veneer Mill, including a foreman position prior to the mill closing. He was employed by Cianbro Corp., of Pittsfield, for many years and as a security guard at the Air Force radar site in Moscow.

He was married Dec. 3, 1955, to Sylvia J. Pelletier, of Bingham.

Captain Dolan served in the National Guard for more than 20 years. He attended service schools in New York, Georgia and Kentucky. He served as commander at the Skowhegan Armory and received an honorable discharge from the Armed Forces of the United States in September 1965.

Doug was a member of the Keystone Lodge 80 A.F.&A.M., of Solon, for more than 40 years. He was a member and past commander of the Stanley Beane Post 99 American Legion in Bingham.

He served on the Bingham Planning Board and the Bingham

Water District.

He was an avid hunter, fisherman and outdoorsman. He enjoyed family outings and trips to the Maine coast. He liked to take trips to Prince Edward Island and lately had enjoyed trips to Foxwoods in Connecticut.

Two brothers, William and John, and a sister, Shirley O'Hara, died previously.

Survivors include his wife, Sylvia (Pelletier) Dolan, of Bingham; son and daughter-in-law, Patrick D. and Leslie J. Dolan, of Levant; daughter and son-in-law, Angela M. and Jay Pratt, of Concord; six grandchildren, Joshua and Katrina Pratt, Matthew and Abigail Dolan, and Corey and Dustin Boivin.

Memorial visitation will be 7-9 p.m. Thursday, Aug. 26, at Giberson Funeral Home, River Street, Bingham.

A memorial service will be held at 1 p.m. Friday, Aug. 27, at the First Congregational Church, Meadow Street, Bingham.

Biddeford, Nov. 26.—Dr. David Ernest Dolloff, 70, practicing physician here the past 40 years, died tonight at his home, 15 Crescent Street, after a brief illness.

He has been chief of staff and chief surgeon at Webber Hospital the past 29 years. Despite advancing years he remained active, and came from partial retirement early in the last war. He served as shop physician of the Saco Lowell Shops 25 years, and was examining physician for the war-time selective service board here.

Doctor Dolloff had gained wide recognition in civic circles as well as in fraternal and patriotic organizations.

Last year he delivered the dedicatory address at Biddeford Memorial Field when he served as chairman of the War Memorial Field Committee. He also organized, in 1947, the first Biddeford PTA group in the history of the city.

Doctor Dolloff was highly regarded in State Department American Legion circles for his assistance to disabled veterans and service officers. He was commander of Philip Tighe Post during its organizational years.

He was one of the sponsors of the movement which produced the famed Philip Tighe Post drum and bugle corps. For ten years this group dominated Maine competition and achieved National recognition.

He was born at Munroe of Horace and Abigail T. Dolloff. He attended Munroe schools and was graduated from Castine Normal School in 1906. He taught a few years at Brooks and Bristol and later entered Bowdoin Medical School, where he received his degree.

He interned for a year at the Salem, Mass., hospital, and in 1908 started private practice in Biddeford with the late Dr. M. Hubbard Ferguson.

In 1917, he enlisted in the Army Medical Corps and was sent overseas. He was lent to the British and served as physician and surgeon at the Manor Hospital in England.

He was a member of the American College of Physicians and Surgeons and the American, Maine and York County medical associations.

He served as chief medical officer of the local Civilian Defense during World War II, and was active in Red Cross work and with the Public Health Nursing service.

At one time he served on the Biddeford Board of Education, was a member of the Police Commission, and while serving as Biddeford Park Commissioner developed what is now Clifford Park into the city's first playground.

He was a member of Dunlap Lodge, F & AM; Bradford Commandery, Knights Templar; Adah Chapter, OES; Laconia Lodge, IOOF, and Foss Street Methodist Church.

He leaves his widow, Carrie Rand Dolloff; a son, Norman H. Dolloff, Les Gatos, Calif.; one daughter, Mrs. Weslene D. Troy, Providence, R. I.; his mother at Munroe; four grandchildren, a brother, Melroy C., of Munroe, several nieces and nephews.
