Jim was predeceased in 2002 by Alice, his loving wife of 71 years; son Richard; sisters, Frances Brown and Kathleen Copp; and infant granddaughter, Kathleen Raye Douglas.

He is survived by his son, Robert and wife Marion of Westbrook; daughter-in-law, Geraldine Douglas of Brewer; brother, Douglas Holloway and wife Muriel of Augusta; and sisters, Ethel Hoppe of Rockport and Pearl Pinkham of Newcastle. He leaves seven grandchildren, Robert Douglas and wife Barbara of Gorham, Donnelly Douglas and wife Abby of Yarmouth, Stephen Douglas and wife Louise of Windham, Tamara Stolfi and husband Bob of Raymond, Matthew Douglas of Falmouth, Lori Douglas Clark and husband Ken of Readfield, and Richard Douglas and wife Sheila of Brewer. His 15 great-grandchildren are Jamie, Ryan, Joshua, Amber, Kate, Emma, Madison, Logan, Brienn, Brady, Brooke and Craig Douglas; Sean, Emily and Elise Clark; and a great-great-grandson, Sage Douglas-Leahey.
