Surviving Col. Drake are seven nephews and nieces, Fred M. Drake of New York City, Mrs. Adelaide Means of Gardiner, Francis Landers of Boston, Charles W. Drake, Miss Edna Drake and Mrs. Gertrude Springer of Portland and Lloyd Drake of Arlington, Mass.

Lieut.-Col. Frank Elbridge Drake, 64, World War veteran and long identified with the druggist trade in Maine, died this morning at the home of Mrs. Grace M. Drake, his sister-in-law, 115 William Street. He had been in failing health for about a year.

Col. Drake was born in Gardiner Sept. 1, 1872, the son of Elbridge G. and Frances Elwell Drake. He attended the schools of his native city, including Gardiner High School, and then studied at a pharmaceutical college. Service as a clerk in Gardiner and Augusta drug stores was followed by several years as proprietor of a drug business in Farmington, where he was located for many years.

Always interested in the National Guard he was a member of the organization in Maine from early manhood, being advanced through various grades to captain, in which rank he served in the Second Maine Infantry, afterwards the 103rd Regiment, on the Mexican Border in 1916. He went to France with the regiment, which was a part of the 26th Division, one of the first United States units to go over seas after this Country entered the World War. He participated in many of the leading engagements of the war, being promoted to lieutenant colonel, from major, which grade he held upon going overseas.

After the war Col. Drake entered the employ of the J. E. Gould & Company, wholesale druggists, Federal Street, this City, as a salesman, serving until about a year ago, when he resigned on account of his health. He had a wide acquaintance in the State, both in business and military circles.

W. Bath Couple Dies In Blaze

The Young Journalist of the Year award bears his name. He was made an honorary life member of the MPA in April, 1985.

On Sept. 20, 2002, he was inducted into the Maine Press Association Hall of Fame.

He also served during his retirement years as a contributing editor and member of the editorial board at the Sentinel, resigning in 1991 because of failing eyesight. He was active in New England as well as Maine newspaper organizations, serving for several years as a member of the Board of Governors of the New England Society of Newspaper Editors and served a term as the society's secretary-treasurer, and was also an active member of the New England Associated Press News Executives Association.

Drake was born March 4, 1915, in Gardiner, son of Archie and Lena (Tibbetts) Drake and attended Gardiner High School and Boston University College of Business Administration, majoring in journalism. He was a member of the university's Alumni Council. In 1958 he attended an American Press Institute seminar for publishers and chief news executives at Columbia University.
