## W. Bath Couple Dies In Blaze

WEST BATH — Memorial services will be held today for an elderly couple who died early Monday morning as flames turned their two-story oceanfront home on the Birch Point Road into an inferno.

J. Edward Drake Jr., 60, and his wife Carolyn, 61, were found dead in their home after the blaze was extinguished by Bath and West Bath firemen.

A neighbor reportedly called firemen when he heard a loud explosion at the home and saw flames at about 2 a.m. One fireman described the house as "a ball of flames when we arrived."

Surviving are three sons, Dickson and Carey Drake, both of Bath, and J. Edward Drake of Niantic, Conn.; three grandchildren, and a half sister, Mrs. Reginald (Dorothy) Lombard of South Portland.

VASSALBORO -- Robert G. Drake Sr., 92, editor and assistant general manager of the Morning Sentinel for 33 years, passed away Friday, April 13, 2007, in Waterville, after a period of ill health.

Drake joined the Guy Gannett organization in 1936 as a district reporter in Gardiner and retired in 1979 as director of the Sentinel's news operation.

He was city editor of the Kennebec Journal when he was transferred to the Sentinel in 1946 where he served successively as city editor, managing editor and editor. He was also assistant general manager.

Following his retirement he was elected executive secretary of the Maine Press Association, a position he held for six years. He was honored by the MPA as the 1985 Maine Journalist of the Year. The Young Journalist of the Year award bears his name. He was made an honorary life member of the MPA in April, 1985.

On Sept. 20, 2002, he was inducted into the Maine Press Association Hall of Fame.

He also served during his retirement years as a contributing editor and member of the editorial board at the Sentinel, resigning in 1991 because of failing eyesight. He was active in New England as well as Maine newspaper organizations, serving for several years as a member of the Board of Governors of the New England Society of Newspaper Editors and served a term as the society's secretary-treasurer, and was also an active member of the New England Associated Press News Executives Association.

Drake was born March 4, 1915, in Gardiner, son of Archie and Lena (Tibbetts) Drake and attended Gardiner High School and Boston University College of Business Administration, majoring in journalism. He was a member of the university's Alumni Council. In 1958 he attended an American Press Institute seminar for publishers and chief news executives at Columbia University.




