FAIRFIELD — Dana M. Drew, 88 of 2 Park St., died late Wednesday evening, Aug. 17, at a Waterville Nursing Home.

He was born in Fairfield, April 6, 1906, the son of Forest and Alice (Chapman) Drew.

A graduate of Lawrence High School in the Class of 1923, he attended Rider College, from which he graduated in 1926. He began his employment as a salesman with the National Cash Register Co. in New York City.



In the early 1930s he returned to Fairfield and founded the D.M. Drew Roofing Co., which he owned and operated until selling the business and retiring in 1974.

Active in the community, he was a longtime member and past president of the Fairfield Kiwanis Club and had served as chairman for the March of Dimes Fund Raising Drive in Somerset County. His Masonic affiliations included the Siloam Masonic Lodge No. 92 in Fairfield, the Teconett Chapter No. 52 R.A.M. in Waterville, a 50-year member of St. Omer Commandery R.C. Dana was also a member of the Fairfield Historical Society and was an avid hunter and fisherman.

On Sept. 9, 1939, he married Grace Gifford of Fairfield.

Besides his wife, Grace Drew of Fairfield, survivors include three brothers-in-law and five sisters-in-law as well as several nieces and nephews.

Blanche Chaplin Drew, Sr. He attended schools of Portland and graduated from Deering High School. While there, he played in the school band where he met his late wife, Beverly. Mr. Drew served in the Army Air Corps during World War II. Having spent childhood summers at the family cottage on Watchic Lake, he located to Standish after his discharge. In 1950 he built his home there which he called 'Watchic Acres Farm & Cottages.' He also built homes for his three children in the area now called 'Drewville.' He was a farmer and later in life became a carpenter and a representative for a firm that manufactured greenhouses. 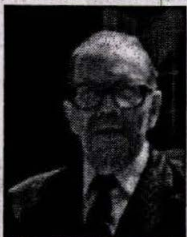

Yarmouth, June 23—Capt. Sumner Pierce Drinkwater, 83, retired master mariner and former employe of the Cumberland County Power and Light Company on its trolley line, died Monday night at his home on the Gilman Road, and private funeral services for relatives will be conducted Thursday at 2 p. m. at the Lindquist funeral home, Portland Street, with burial in Riverside Cemetery.

Captain Drinkwater was a native of this town, the son of Nicholas and Margaret Gray Drinkwater and received his education at the old rural school on Prince's Point. He went to sea at the age of 16 and at 24 held a master mariner's license. His first trip as master was in the schooner Bramhall for W. S. Jordan and Company of Portland, and during his seafaring career he made two 13-month trips around the world. It was his boast that he never lost a ship.

He left the sea in 1902 to enter the employ of the power company, serving both as conductor and motor-man and remaining in the service for 20 years. Captain Drinkwater was twice married, his wife being Alice Gray Drinkwater, whom he married in 1882, and the second, Mabel G. Fels, whom he wed in 1916.
