## Leon Dudley, former S. Berwick police chief

ROLLINSFORD - Leon K. Dudley, 83, of 22 Howe St., died Saturday, July 31, 1993 at the York Hospital after a period of failing health.

He was born Sept. 1, 1909 in Lee, the son of George A. and Grace (Bartlett) Dudley.

He was a graduate of the Lawrence (Mass.) High School and had attended Mass. Institute of Technology. He was a former resident of South Berwick, Maine, prior to moving to Rollinsford 15 years ago.

He was a veteran of World War II, having served in the U.S. Marines and later in the U.S. Army Air Corps.

In his early years, he was a farmer.

Later, he owned and operated the Jenny Service Station in South Berwick, and had also served as the Chief of Police for South Berwick.

He later was a manager at the former Giant Store in Dover.

He was a member of the Rollinsford Post No. 47 American Legion; the South Berwick Veterans of Foreign Wars Post; was a 35-year member of the St. John's Lodge No. 51, A.F. & A.M. of So. Berwick, the Salmon Falls Sportsman's Club and was the founder and life member of the South Berwick Police Association.

Leon was a communicant of the First Parish Federated Church of South Berwick.

His first wife, Ora Lee (Howell) Dudley, died in 1977 and he was the widower of Theresa (Marcotte) Dudley, who died last year.

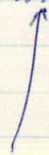

Damariscotta, Dec. 9—Kendall M. Dunbar, 77, for 16 years secretary of the Maine Senate and for 20 years chairman of the Board of Selectmen at Damariscotta, died this morning at his home here following an illness of four years.

Mr. Dunbar was born Sept. 18, 1857 at Nobleboro, the son of the late Edward W. and Lucinda Burnham Dunbar. He was educated in the Damariscotta schools and at Lincoln Academy and studied law in the office of Charles F. Libby in Portland. He was a member of the Lincoln County Bar.

Mr. Dunbar, in company with a brother, E. E. Dunbar, established The Damariscotta Herald, now known as The Lincoln County News, and continued his connection with the publication for 17 years. He was elected assistant secretary of the Senate in 1887 and held that position six years and then was elected secretary, a position which he held until he was named

private secretary to Gov. Bert M. Fernald in 1909. He retired from this position with the election of Gov. Frederick W. Plaisted, Democrat, but was retained as a financial advisor of the new administration.

In addition to serving on the Damariscotta Board of Selectmen for many years, he had been town treasurer until his health forced his retirement. He was a member of Alna Lodge, F. and A. M.; a trustee of the Damariscotta Baptist Church and a former president of the Maine Press Association.

Mr. Dunbar was widely known in State Republican circles and was regarded as an authority on State finances. He married the former Laura E. Castner of Damariscotta, June 27, 1885.

Mr. Dunbar is survived, besides his widow, by a brother, William Dunbar of Damariscotta.

The funeral will be conducted at 2 p. m. Wednesday in the Baptist Church with the Rev. Edward A. Sherwood officiating. Interment will be in Northern Cemetery.

William Parker Dunbar was born Feb. 25, 1920, the son of Henry H. and Madeline P. Dunbar. He was the second of three children. He attended Weir Grammar School in Taunton, Mass., and Taunton High School, class of 1938, of which he was president. While he was in high school, he was major of the high school drill team as his father had been before him. In March 1942 he was admitted to officers candidate school and graduated in May as a lieutenant. In November 1942, he married his high school sweetheart Alice Ewing of North Dighton, Mass. In January 1943 he was shipped overseas to Cardiff, Wales, then to the North Africa where he served in Oran and Algeria, and the cities of Bizerte and Tunis in Tunisia. After the invasion of Italy, he was sent to Naples. His job during this time was supervising the unloading of liberty ships. He was discharged from the army in March 1946.

After the war, he graduated from the University of Pennsylvania, then got a job in the pharmaceutical industry. He and his wife moved to Maine in 1947, living first in Cape Elizabeth, then Portland for many years, then finally Falmouth. In 1990 he retired from Dow Chemical Company as a senior sales specialist.

He was president of The Traveling Men's Association, 1966 -1967. An enthusiastic golfer, he was a member of the Portland Country Club and the Maine Seniors Golf Association. He was also a member of Deering Lodge No. 183, of the Free and Accepted Masons.
