Rev. Dunnack left his pulpit, he said, because he believed he could preach to a larger congregation through the medium of good books.

Mr. Dunnack used to say that libraries stood only below religious influence, home training and the public schools in the development of good citizens.

While he built up the state library and inaugurated the state's traveling library system, the Rev. Dunnack gained considerable fame throughout Maine as a lecturer on Maine's early life.

At one time he was president of the National Association of State Librarians.

Nearly 10 years ago he tried to get the State to build a \$500,000 building to house his ever-growing library, but did not live to see his wish fulfilled.

Capt. Harvey L. Dunning, 62, of 18 Arthur St., Portland, and Jonesport, a harbor pilot and former steamship captain, collapsed and died at Beals late Saturday.

He was born in Jonesboro June 6, 1899, son of George and Cora Rogers Dunning. He went to Jonesport schools.

Capt. Dunning was the senior Portland harbor pilot and president of the Portland Pilots Association. Before joining the pilots five years ago, he served 30 years with Eastern Steamship Lines, many of them as ship's master.

One of his last commands with the ESL was the S.S. Evangeline, which ran between Boston and the Maritimes. During World War II he commanded Liberty and Victory ships on the Atlantic convoy route. He also commanded a ship that participated in the invasion of Normandy in 1944.

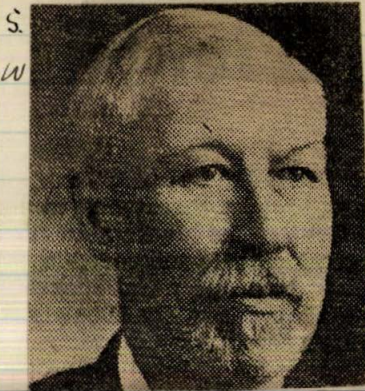

Rev Eliot, June 15.—Dr. Henry I. Durgin, 75, widely known as a country doctor in Southwestern Maine, died today at his home at Bolt Hill. His death was less than a week after he had been honored by the Maine Medical Society with the presentation of a 50-year medal.

Dr. Durgin was a native of Freedom, N. H., and was graduated in March, 1889, from New York University Medical School. He first started to practice in Newfields, Maine, but came here in the Fall of 1889 to assist the late Dr. John L. Willis, who had suffered a knee injury.

Dr. Durgin was very prominent in fraternal circles, being a past master of Naval Lodge of Masons of Kittery; Unity Royal Arch Chapter, South Berwick; Maine Council, Royal and Select Masters, of Saco; past thrice potentate master of Ineffable Grand Lodge of Perfection of Portsmouth; past sovereign prince, Grand Council, Princes of Jerusalem; New Hampshire Chapter, Order of Rose Croix, of Dover; New Hampshire Consistory of Nashua; Kora Temple, Mystic Shrine, of Lewiston; DeWitt Clinton Commandery, Knights Templar, of Portsmouth; past patron of Piscataqua Chapter, No. 90 Order of the Eastern Star of Kittery; past sachem, St. Aspinquid Tribe of Red Men of Kittery; past chancellor commander, Constitution Lodge, Knights of Pythias of Kittery; past president of the York County Medical Society; Maine Medical Association; American Medical Association; past president of the John Paul Jones Club; Piscataqua Pioneers; John F. Hill Grange; Alpha Council, Royal Arcanum; Warwick Club of Portsmouth; the New Hampshire Free Masons' Association, and the Massachusetts Society, Sons of the American Revolution.

He was a member of the Congregational Church and a trustee of the Fogg Memorial Library here. His widow, Mrs. Alta Knox Durgin, to whom he was married 48 years ago last December, survives. The funeral will be held Sunday afternoon at the Congregational Church.
