

Dr. Bertrand F. Dunn, who was 98 years old on Jan. 9, Portland's oldest physician and one of her few remaining Civil War veterans, died Saturday at his home at 203 Brackett Street. He cast his first political ballot for Abraham Lincoln, and remained a staunch Republican forever after. Dr. Dunn was married on his 25th birthday in 1869 to Miss Clara A. Towle of Westbrook, and on the following day left with his bride for Harrison where he opened his first office. There, for a year, and later at Windham Hill, he lived the life of a country doctor.
