## Dana A. Eastman

LEWISTON — Dana A. Eastman, 82, of 149 Highland Terrace, Mexico, died Wednesday, Dec. 11, at the Central Maine Medical Center after a short illness. He had lived in the Mexico area most of his life.



He was born Jan. 28, 1914, the son of Victor and Zephyr (McGraw) Eastman.

He graduated from Dixfield High School with the class of 1932 and graduated from Bliss Business College.

LOVELL -- Gordon M. Eastman, 89, perhaps better known by his nickname, Stub, passed away peacefully at his home on May 12, 2006.

Stub was born in Lovell, on Dec. 15, 1916, the son of Max and Mabel (Brooks) Eastman. Stub received his education in Lovell schools and graduated from Fryeburg Academy in 1934.

He married Frances A. Rich of Norway on June 10, 1939 and together raised their children, Gordon (Stubby) M. Eastman Jr., and Patricia L. Eastman Bryan.

Stub worked as a farmer, woodsman and bus driver before joining the Maine State Forest Service in 1948. He served 28 years as a district ranger.

Stub was an active participant in the formation of the Lovell Volunteer Fire Department and was a member and past president of the Western Maine Fire Fighters Association. Stub contributed a life-time of community service to his home town. He was an active member of the Lovell Town Government, which included serving on various committees and serving as Selectman for 23 years. Eastman, 56, veteran of the Spanish-American and the World Wars, and associated with his father, the late Tobias Eastman in the general store business here, died last night at St. Petersburg, Fla., where he was spending part of the Winter. His son, Robert B. Eastman, left immediately upon receiving word today to fly to Florida to make arrangements for bringing the body of his father North. His father died about Christmas time.


