SOUTH THOMASTON — Albert Burbank Elliot, 86, died Oct. 24, 1994, at his home after a long illness.

Brunswick, April 1—Dr. Gilbert M. Elliott, 72, for nearly half a century a practicing physician here, several years a county medical examiner, prominent in National Guard activities and in fraternal order circles, died today at Brattleboro, Vt.

Born in New York City, Dr. Elliott was graduated from the City College, received his degree of doctor of medicine from Columbia University in 1889 and the degree of master of science from City College in 1890.

Two years later he came to Brunswick and remained four years, after which he went to Europe for study at Vienna and Munich. He returned to this town in 1896. He was formerly a member of the National Guard of New York and joining the Maine Guard, he became first lieutenant and assistant surgeon in the First Maine Infantry, holding this rank in the War with Spain, when he was assigned to the divisional hospital at Chickamauga. He was in charge of the hospital train that returned to Maine ahead of the regular troop trains.

He subsequently became a major in the Guard and following the disastrous explosion in the harbor of Halifax, N. S., in 1917 he was in charge of the medical unit from this state stationed in the Canadian city. Dr. Elliott was assigned to the Bowdoin College unit as a medical officer in charge of infantry training during the World War, and for several years he was a quartermaster of the rifle team from Maine competing in the national shoot at Camp Perry, Ohio.

For many years he was a member of the Brunswick Board of Health and he was a member of the School Board 27 years.

He was a member of the Maine Medical Association, the Association of Military Surgeons, the Association of American Anatomists, United Spanish War Veterans and the American Legion.

He was also affiliated with the Masonic bodies, Odd Fellows, Red Men, Knights of the Golden Eagle and Royal Arcanum. His college fraternities were Delta Kappa Epsilon and Alpha Kappa Kappa.

He leaves a widow; a son, Gilbert M. Elliott, Jr., and a daughter, Mrs. William D. Ireland of Massachusetts.
