THE GRAND MASTER.

His Masonic Service Recounted in the Cimarron Jacksonian.

At the 81st annual communication of the Most Worshipful Grand Lodge, Ancient Free and Accepted Masons of Kansas held at Wichita the 17th and 18th of February, Charley B. Erskine of Cimarron was elected grand master. This is the highest Masonic honor that can be given a Mason in Kansas.

There are 62,552 Masons in Kansas and 447 separate lodges, all under the jurisdiction of the grand master. Seldom does this honor come to the western part of the state, as naturally the

larger number of the members are located in the eastern third.

Charley Erskine is a member of Preston Lodge No. 283, Cimarron, having petitioned the local lodge in February 1910, on a demit from Riverside Lodge No. 137, Jefferson, Maine where he received the degrees in 1904. He was elected to membership in the local lodge on March 9, 1910 and has been active in its affairs ever since. In 1912 he served the lodge as master and for several years was its secretary.

In February 1912 he attended his first session of the Grand Lodge and since that time has missed two of the sessions. He has held a number of appointments in the Grand Lodge and
