

Born in Brewer, a son of Everett and Ruth Foster England, he attended Brewer schools, was a graduate of Brewer High School and attended Husson College.

He served with the Air National Guard in Bangor, and was a former member and chairman of the Brewer School Board.

The Englands moved to South Portland about 20 years ago.

He served on the Planning Board from 1979 to 1993.

Mr. England helped oversee planning for much of the city's growth in the Maine Mall area.

"He was a very conscientious member," said Cathy Counts, secretary to the board. "His attendance was 100 percent, except for a funeral or a vacation.

"He made site visits, he read his material and he was well versed on the business before him during the heaviest period of the city's development."

William Laidley, who served with Mr. England on the board, said, "He had a great institutional memory. He had been on the board longer than most of us, and was able to point out that a lot of things before us weren't new. He could boint out what happened in the past."

new. He could point out what happened in the past." Mr. England's son, Thomas E. England II, said his father's lifelong interest was in the Order of DeMolay. "In this organization he helped many young men," said his son, "He felt that he had been aided by it, and wanted to help others."

With DeMolay, Mr. England was a member of the Bangor Chapter, treasurer of its Maine Association and a lifetime supporter of the order. He was instrumental in reforming the Phil Drader Coronation Chapter in Riverview, New Brunswick, and was an adviser of the Frank S. Land Chapter in South Portland.

Dana C. Ryder, of Standish, an official of the South Portland unit, said Mr. England was planning a trip to the DeMolay international convention in June. "It's the 75th anniversary and he had organized a bus trip all the way to Kansas City," said Ryder. "We were taking about 40 youngsters and advisers.


"He was dedicated to the organization. He wanted to give back some of the good things it had given to him."





THE GRAND MASTER.

His Masonic Service Recounted in the Cimarron Jacksonian.

At the 81st annual communication of the Most Worshpful Grand Lodge, Ancient Free and Accepted Masons of Kansas held at Wichita the 17th and 18th of February, Charley B. Erskine of Cimarron was elected grand master. This is the highest Masonic honor that can be given a Mason in Kansas.

There are 62,552 Masons in Kansas and 447 separate lodges, all under the jurisdiction of the grand master. Seldom does this honor come to the western part of the state, as naturally the

He was elected to membership in the local lodge on March 9, 1910 and has been active in its affairs ever since. In 1912 he served the lodge as master and for several years was its secretary. In February 1912 he attended his first session of the Grand Lodge and since that time has missed two of the sessions.
