**HARMONY** — Lyman Calvin Farrin, 83, also known by his grandchildren as "Ole Kid" died Saturday, Aug. 18, 2001, at a Dexter healthcare facility surrounded by his family.

## Carroll W. Farrington

SOUTH CHINA — Carroll W. Farrington, 67, of Arnold Road, died June 20, 1990, at Maine Medical Center, Portland.

He was born in Waterville, July 4, 1922, the son of Cecil and Hazel Higgins Farrington.

A 1940 graduate of Erskine Academy, Mr. Farrington was a technical sergeant in the Army during World War II and was awarded a Silver Star. He served in the 103rd Infantry, 43rd Division in the Pacific Theater with combat duty campaigns in Guadalcanal, North Solomons and New Guinea.

Farrington of San Diego, Calif.; three brothers, Paul L. Farrington and Milton H. Farrington, both of South China, and Donald E. Farrington of Manchester, N.H.; three grandchildren and several nieces, nephews and cousins.

His father died in 1955 and his twin brother, Carlton F. Farrington, died in 1980.
