

FARMINGTON - William "Bill" Fedishen, 83, of Farmington died peacefully at home on April 1 after a courageous battle with cancer.

He was born in New Jersey, Sept. 10, 1917, the son of Alex and Antonia Fedchyshyn. His parents owned a truck farm and he worked on the family farm until leaving for active military duty in 1942.

He had a lifelong love of aviation and earned his pilot's license at 16 years of age. He enlisted in the United States Army Air Corp, the precursor to the modern Air Force, where he served as a flight instructor for hundreds of World War II pilots. He always said he regretted not flying bombing missions, but his commanding officers said his training abilities were too valuable to risk sending him overseas.

Following his years in the service, he worked as a commercial pilot for Trans-Caribbean Airlines flying throughout the Caribbean Islands, including his favorite island of Aruba. During this time, he did some corporate flying for clients that included the infamous Robert Vesco. Never one to be idle, he also continued giving flight instructions to private pilots and ran his own construction company. He maintained his flight instructor certification until 1989.

He moved to Farmington in 1977 where he continued to work as a contractor for several more years. He was multilingual with fluency in Ukrainian and Russian but it was in English that he never hesitated

to share his opinion on everything. An accomplished violinist and harmonica player, he especially enjoyed entertaining

family and friends by playing ribald ditties.

After retirement, his daily routine included driving his pick-up truck into town accompanied by his beloved dachshund, to pick up mail and stop by Don's AG for a cup

of coffee, the newspaper, and a few minutes of friendly banter with the clerks.

He was a long time member of the OX5 Club whose membership consists of pilots who flew airplanes with the OX5 engine. He also belonged to the Quiet Birdmen, a club founded by World War I pilots known for their exuberant parties. Hence the tongue-in cheek name of Quiet Birdmen. He was a member of the Farmington Lion's Club and a Third Degree Mason.

He is survived by his wife, Marie, of Farmington; sons, Michael of Carbondale, Colo., James of Tucson, Ariz., and Richard of New Lisbon, N.J.; daughter, Karen Harris and her husband Richard of Anderson, Ark.; stepsons, Russell Nahirny and his wife, Virginia of Swampscott, Mass., and David Nahirny and his wife, Crystal of Houston, Texas; three grandchildren, Ben and Adria Fedishen of Colo., Nathan Harris of Ark.; and two stepchildren, Paige Nahirny of Massachusetts, and Nate Nahirny of Texas.

He was predeceased by his brother, Michael in 1999; and two former wives.

He was awarded the Winslow Field Hockey Fan of the Year award in 1991. He loved fiddleheading, berrying, making jam, cooking, canning, and was known for his great cookies.

The Maine outdoors was a big part of his life. As a young man he was a Maine Guide. He was proud of his hunting and fishing skills. He was a member of many hunting and fishing organizations. October and November, he could be found at his camp in the Lenard Woods.

The Portland Sunday paper featured a page of him at his camp a few years ago.
