George M. Fernald, 70, retired mail carrier, died at his home 128 Cumberland Avenue Tuesday evening. He had been in failing health a long time but had been seriously ill only two weeks.

When he retired in 1931 after 44 years in the postal service, Mr. Fernald was the oldest carrier in point of service in the Portland Postoffice. He was born in Portland June 11, 1864. He was employed a short time by the C. V. Varney Company, wholesale flour dealers, and later learned the shoemaker's trade, being employed by several local firms.

He was appointed a substitute carrier April 7 1887 and a regular carrier the following month. When he was appointed to the service there were but 16 carriers on the force of the Portland postoffice. For a time he handled registered mail throughout the city, before it was assigned to regular carriers for delivery. He covered the old Route Three on the northerly side of Congress Street from Washington Avenue to Pearl Street. He later was assigned to Route Nine which covers City Hall, adjacent buildings and Myrtle Street. The last few years of his service he delivered mail in the Press Herald Building, making three trips daily through the seven-story building.

Mr. Fernald was a member of the Portland Lodge of Masons and of Forest City Lodge, A. O. U. W.

Surviving are a daughter, Mrs. Maynard S. Dean, and a grandson, Lawrence S. Dean.

Don was a fine example of the power of independent spirit and took great pride in his family and their origins. He maintained a fierce interest in his Scottish heritage and studied Gaelic weekly.
