WILLIAM F. FERNALD

FARMINGDALE - William F. Fernold, 74, of 34 Park Street, died Tuesday, Oct. 5, 1999, at his home. He was born in Winterport, Aug. 25, 1925, the son of Frederick A. and Anna (Downes) Fernold.

He attended the public schools of Winterport and graduated from the Maine Maritime Academy in 1945. He was a veteran of World War II and retired from active Naval Reserves in 1965. He was employed by the Bangor and Aroostook Railroad for 11 years. He was Director of Transportation for the Maine Public Utilities Commission from 1957-1970. In 1972, he joined the Maine Department of Transportation and retired from that agency as Deputy Commissioner in 1986. Mr. Fernald was president of the National Association of State Transportation Specialists in 1966-67. In 1982 he was the recipient of the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials Presidents Modal Award for furthering Water Transportation. In 1983 he received Poultryman of the Year Award for helping Maine formers achieve parity in Rail Freight Rates. He was married to Harriet Travis in Bangor, June 16, 1945. He was an active Free Mason, including membership in the York Rite Bodies of Gardiner, the Scottish Rite Bodies of Augusta. Kora Temple Shrine of Lewiston,

past president of Kennebec Valley Shrine Club. He received the 33rd and last degree of the Ancient Accepted Scottish Rite of Free Masanry in 1993. Mr. Fernald was a member of the Highland Avenue United Methodist Church of Gardiner. In the latter years of his life he was active amateur historian and genealogist. He was a member of the Maine Historical Society and past member of the New England Historic Genealogical Society and Maine Genealogical Society.

He was predeceased by his daughter, Ann Fernald Ray, who died Feb. 17, 1999. He is survived by his wife of Farmingdale; his daughter, Beverly LaPlante of Gardiner; two grandchildren, Robert LaPlante and Carol LaPlante of Gardiner; a brother, Richard H. Fernald of Brewer; a sister, Maryanna Moran of Winterport; several nieces and nephews.

There will be no funeral or visiting hours. A memorial service will be held at the Highland Avenue United Methodist Church in Gardiner on Sunday, October 10, 1999, at 2 p.m. Memorial donations may be made to the Shriners Hospital. Envelopes will be available. Burial will be in Oak Grove Cemetery, Gardiner. Arrangements under the care of Staples Funeral Home, Gardiner.

terrell Herbert Ross YARMOUTH - Herbert Ross Ferrell, 59, of 28 Bridge Offici St. died Friday in a Portland hospital after a long illness.

> A pioneer in the Maine motel business, he built and was associated with Down East Village Motel and Restaurant here, serving as president, until ill health forced his retirement two years ago.

> He was the first president of the Maine Motel Association and was president again the year it merged with the Maine Hotel Association. forming the Maine Inkeepers. of which he was an honorary member.

A resident of Yarmouth for 27 years and in business here since 1946, he formerly was associated with the R.C. Nichols Corp., a mail order sporting goods company.

He was born in Elizabethtown, Ill., son of Henry A. and Nora Gerhardt Ferrell.

At one time, Ferrell was employed by the Army Corps of Engineers on the Ohio River. He enlisted in the Army Air Corps in 1941 and received a commission as a communications officer. He was awarded the Bronze Star following the Battle of the Bulge.

He was past president of the Yarmouth Chamber of Commerce and was instrumental in establishing the Yarmouth Clam Festival.

He was a member of the Masons of Yarmouth, the Portland Country Club and the former president of Vacationland Inc.

Survivors include his wife, the former Barbara V. Jaeger; two sons, H. Ross Jr. of Bangor and Edward H. of Yarmouth; a daughter, Virginia M. Ferrell of Fairbanks. Alaska: two brothers. Harold of Elizabethtown, Ill., and Herschel of Bedford, Ind.; three sisters, Jean Penny and Rose Ferrell, both of Elizabethtown, Ill., and Ruby Kerr of Rosiclare, Ill.; and three grandchildren.



His first venture in the scallop trade was peddling 25 pounds about the city of Rockland, a task which required all day to dispose of his stock, he said. Later he began to dispose of scallops for fishermen hereabouts, and by 1927 he was buying and selling more scallops than all the other dealers along the coast, winning for himself the title of "king" of the trade.

Appointed commissioner by Gov. Louis J. Brann, as a successor to Horatio C. Crie of Rockland, Mr. Feyler immediately undertook a program for the conservation, propagation and exploitation of Maine's fishing industry and for the betterment of conditions among the men engaged in it.

His projects, which envisioned an era when at least 50,000 persons in this State would be employed in fishing and fish-processing, received the endorsement of many leading citizens. He made a thorough study of the different uses of fish by-products, and at one time investigated a process developed by Germans for the manufacture of leather from fish skins.

With Governor Brann, he succeeded in inducing the government to buy surplus Maine fish and the two led in the fight against the misrepresentation of crawfish as lobsters. Many of the old theories in administering the affairs of the sea and shore department were discarded by Mr. Feyler when he became commissioner.

He requested reappointment by Governor Lewis O. Barrows, but was succeeded by Arthur R. Greenleaf of Boothbay Harbor.

Mr. Feyler, who served as acting manager for the big plant of the General Seafoods Corporation when it opened here three years ago, conducted an extensive fish and lobster business, his products going to the majority of the states in the Union. He owned a huge filleting plant and once had a large cold storage and freezing establishment.

Surviving are his widow, Gertrude; a son, Richard, associated with him in business; a daughter, Mrs. Barbara Wadsworth, Camden; five grandchildren; a brother, Walter, and three sisters, Miss Mary Feyler, Mrs. Ruth Wallace and Mrs. Lista Hyler, all of Thomaston.



L. C. Fickett, Retired Ship Master, Dies

Capt. Leaman C. Fickett, 73, of 1757 Washington Avenue, one of the last of the old square rigger masters, died Monday morning in Sallors' Sung Harbor, Staten Island, N. Y., where he had resided since 1929. He had been in failing health about three years.

Captain Fickett, born March 13, 1867, at Harrington, of an old seafaring family, followed the sea man and boy all his life. He had an allcoverage license for the seven seas and sailed his square-rigged and schooner-rigged ships to all parts of the world.

In the years before his retirement he was master for the Emery fleet of Boston and the Crowell & Thurlow fleet of the same port. One of his last schooners was the four-masted Rockland-built Theoline, which he commanded four years. 
