DR. FREDERICK H. FILES! News of the death of Dr. Frederick H. Files who died at Madisen, South Dakota, March 1 after one week's sickness with pneumonia has been received in this city. Dr. Files was born in Gorham.

After spending many years vacationing in Greenville, Dr. and Mrs. Fillebrown moved there permanently in 1979. Besides his wife, the former Jennie Sproul, he leaves a son and daughter-inlaw, Donald L. and Sherrie Fillebrown of Somersworth, N.H.; along with cousins in the Ayer, Mass. area. 





The service is private. Arrangements are by Bibber Memorial Chapel.




