CHARLES E. FILES

CORNISH—Charles E. (Ed-die) Files, 70, former Portland High School athletic instructor and ex-major league ball player, died here yesterday at his home. He had been in ill health several months.

Mr. Files served as athletic instructor and taught German and English in Portland in 1911-12. He graduated in 1908 from Bowdoin College where he was an outstanding baseball and football player. He was president of the class and captain of the baseball team in his junior year. He was president of the Athletic Council at Bowdoin.

After graduating from Bowdoin he joined the Philadelphia Athletics for a year and a half. He later pitched for Holyoke of the Connecticut League, Providence in the Eastern League and Worcester in the New England League. Before coming to Portland High School, Mr. Files taught French and Latin at Rockridge Hall, Wellesley Hills, Mass. He also was instructor of boxing, baseball and football there. He later was employed as a bond salesman.

Mr. Files was born in Portland, May 19, 1883, son of Charles G. and Emma Woodman Files. He had lived in Cornish the past 18 years.

He was affiliated with the Cornish Congregational Church and was a member of Greenleaf Lodge, AF&AM; Aurora Royal Arch Masons, Kora Temple, Scottish Rites bodies. He also was a member of the Maine Senior Golf Club Association, the Portland Athletic Club and the Cornish Chamber of Commerce.

Surviving are his widow, Elsie May Littlefield Files; two sisters, Edith and Margaret Files of this town; a nephew and several cousins.

Masonic funeral services will be held at the home at 2:30 p. m. Thursday. Burial will be in Riverside Cemetery here.

DR. FREDERICK H. FILES. 1911

News of the death of Dr. Frederick H. Files who died at Madison, South Dakota, March 1 after one week's sickness with pneumonia has been received in this city. Dr. Files was born in Gorham.

He graduated from Bowdoin college and Bowdoin Medical school in the class of 1889. After serving one year as house physician at the Maine General hospital he married Miss Mary B. Meserve, a niece of F. W. Coolidge of this city. He went West several years ago and located at Sioux Falls, South Dakota.

He was for 10 years in partnership with Dr. H. W. Subern and in 1900 he became associated with a Dr. Clough in a private hospital in Madison. He served as the senior dental officer of the Third Marine Air Wing, Cherry Point, N.C. and as a lieutenant commander aboard the U.S.S. Zenobia, AKA-52, touring Iceland. Upon completion of active duty, he attended the U.S. Naval Dental School in Bethesda, Md. During his years in Greenfield, Dr. Fillebrown was president of the Franklin County Public Health Association; was appointed as examining dental physician for the Dental Draft Board; served as president of the Franklin County Dental Association; as well as belonging to various civic organizations. For a number of years he was very involved in the Greenfield Scouting Program, most notably with Boy Scout Troop No. 5. He was a member of Republican Lodge of Masons for over 50 years, serving as the lodge organist for a number of years. Dr. Fillebrown was an avid gardener. His passion being the growing and cultivating of orchids. From his home base greenhouse he provided these delicate flowers to the local florists in the

Greenfield area. Dr. and Mrs. Fillebrown enjoyed traveling, visiting Hawaii, Germany, Austria, Holland, as well as frequent trips to visit friends in California, Pennsylvania and Florida, where for many years, they had a second home. After spending many years vacationing in Greenfield, Dr. and Mrs. Fillebrown moved there permanently in 1979. Besides his wife, the former Jennie Sproul, he leaves a son and daughter-in-law, Donald L. and Sherrie Fillebrown of Somersworth, N.H.; along with cousins in the Ayer, Mass. area. Belfast, Dec. 29—Walking in the storm this morning to the grocery store on Church Street where he had been a clerk or member of the firm for 54 years, Ben Davis Field, 72, widely known Waldo County business man, fell dead just after his arrival.

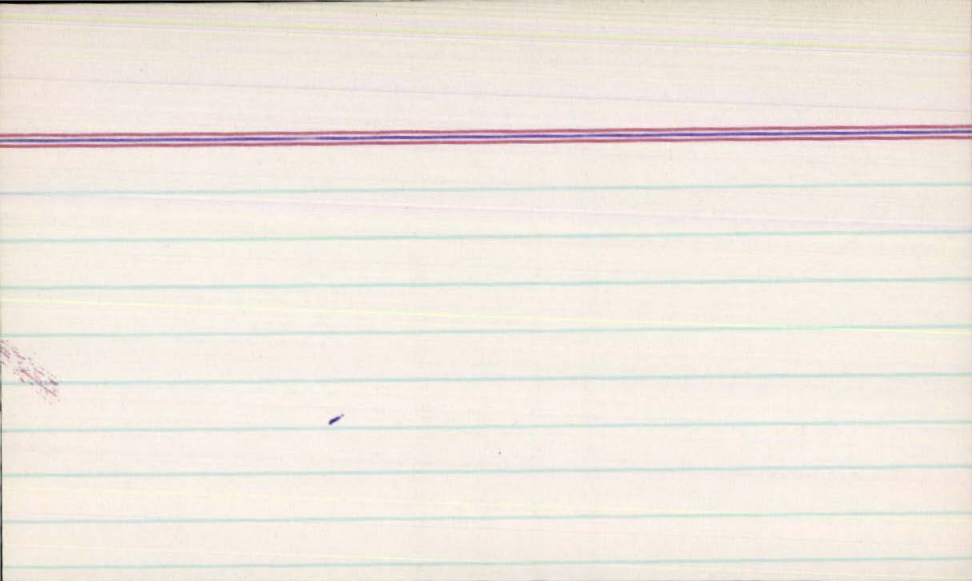
