
William W. Fish Dies At Freeport Long Undertaker And Merchant

John Fisher, Former South Portland Man, Dies In New Jersey

Engaged in Business In Cape City For Many Years Choir Director Sour 3-30-1869

John E. Fisher, former prominent business man of South Portland and well known in both the Cape and this City, died in a sanitarium at Morristown, N. J., Saturday, after an illness of several months.

Mr. Fisher spent most of his life in South Portland where he engaged in business and was active in religious and social affairs. He organzed the Marine Hardware Equipment Company in that City after being affiliated with the Thomas Laughlin Company for a great many years. While a resident of the Cape City Mr. Fisher was a member of the People's M. E. Church, and directed the choir there. He was also a member of the choir at St. Luke's Cathedral, Portland.

The deceased was the son of the late William and Esther Fisher and was a native of Peaks Island. Eleven years ago he went to New York and from here to Cranford, N. J., where he spent the last years of his life. Mr. Fisher was president of the Cranford Bank and was active in the church affairs of that community.
