Laurence W. Fitch owned Fitch's General Store

SEBAGO — Laurence W. Fitch, 77, the fourth-generation proprietor of Fitch's General Store in East Sebago, died here Sunday after a long illness.

In 1957, Mr. Fitch took over historic Fitch's General Store, just off Route 114 near Sebago Lake. The store was founded by his grandfather, Luther Fitch, in 1830,

and was recently added to the National Register of Historic Places.

In keeping with the tradition of a rural New England general store, Mr. Fitch and his wife, Vera, stocked a wide variety of groceries, hardware and other goods. He sold everything from mailboxes to toilet seats to four different sizes of animal traps. Until five years ago he had a molasses barrel and a vinegar barrel.

"He enjoyed the store terribly," said Penny Parker, companion of

Robert Fitch, Mr. Fitch's son. "You could find anything in that store. Contractors came from all over, just to get one of these, and five feet of that. It was all there — every compression fitting, every screw, nut, bolt. He had pipes, screens, glass and mirror."

"I am here for the times when you run out of things," Mr. Fitch said in a 1995 Press Herald interview. "A big store might have 50 (of something) but I have one or two. I'm a fill-in store as most of your mom-and-pop stores are."

Fitch's was open seven days a week, even on Christmas until 1 o'clock. Every day for the past 15 years. Mr. Fitch's cat, "Kitty," could usually be found lounging on the counter.

The Fitches had no employees, but their son, Jack, a fifth-grade teacher in Raymond, helped on weekends, holidays and summer vacations. Mr. and Mrs. Fitch rarely went on vacation together because one of them had to mind the store.

Mr. Fitch was a descendant of William Fitch, one of the first settlers of Sebago. After arriving in 1793, William Fitch built the first sawmill and grist mill in town. His family built the East Sebago store in 1830. It was moved in 1920 to the current location.

Mr. Fitch retired from store work about a year ago. Fitch's Store will stay open through the summer, but plans are uncertain after that.

For 45 years, he was a member of the Sebago Volunteer Fire Department, 20 years as treasurer. He was past president of Spaulding Memorial Library and treasurer of the Joseph Fitch Potter Fund.

Mr. Fitch was postmaster of East Sebago back when the post office was in the store. He served on the planning board and was a member of the North Sebago Cemetery Association. He was a 50-year member of both the Standish Masonic Lodge and American Legion, and a member of the Kora Temple Shrine.

A lifelong resident, he was a son of Montford P. and Elaine W. Ward Fitch. He graduated from Hebron Academy and attended Becker Junior College.

During World War II, he served in the Army Air Corps.

Surviving are his wife of 48 years, Vera M. Fitch of Sebago; three sons, Robert and Ward, both of Sebago, and Jack of Raymond; a daughter, Jill of Lebanon, N.H.; two sisters, Eleanor Case of Cape Coral, Fla., and Pauline Brigham of Portland; seven grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.

Visiting hours will be from 6-8 p.m. Wednesday at Dolby Funeral Chapel, Windham, where a funeral will be held at 7 p.m. Thursday with Maurice Geoffroy officiating. Burial will be private.

FARMINGTON — Lewis G. Fitch, 80, of Stewart Avenue died Monday morning at Franklin Memorial Hospital following a long illness. He was born Aug. 6, 1904, in Westport, Conn., son of Albert and Georgietta Fitch Fitch.

At the age of 3, he moved with his family to New Sharon, where he received his education. Mr. Fitch married the former Ida Munroe of Gardiner, June 6, 1930. Mrs. Fitch passed away June 9, 1979.

Mr. Fitch was a well-known businessman in the New Sharon and Farmington areas. He purchased the Elias Bean Shingle Mill in 1921, which he operated for many years. In 1951 he purchased some Main Street property in Farmington and built a home-office building and planing mill. He moved his family from New Sharon to Farmington in 1952 and purchased land on outer Maple Avenue where he built a saw mill in 1953. The business flourished and soon he added all as-

pects of hardware to the building materials. He and his wife operated the business until his retirement in April 1967, when he sold the business to the L.C. Andrews Co.

Mr. Fitch was a 58-year member of Franklin Masonic Lodge, No. 123, and a past master in 1937. He was a past-member of 15 years for the Farmington Rotary and a 55-year member of Messalunskit Chapter, Order of the Eastern Star, No. 170.

He is survived by his daughter, Mrs. John (Marjorie) Neal of Farmington; one brother, Lester Fitch of New Sharon; three grandchildren; one great-grandchild.

Services will be held Wednesday at 3 p.m. at the Henderson Memorial Baptist Church of Farmington, with Chandler Woodcock officiating. Friends may call today from 6-8 p.m. at the Keegan Funeral Home, 5 Hill St., Farmington. Interment will be in the Fairview Cemetery, Farmington.
