Stricken with a shock a week ago while attending a loan and building association convention in Cincinnati, Charles F. Flagg, 73, member of the Portland Civil Service Commission, died there Saturday morning, according to word received here. Mr. Flagg was widely known here in civic and political circles.

He was born at Kewanee, Ill., Dec. 16, 1862, and had lived in Portland nearly 60 years. After graduating from Portland High School, Mr. Flagg entered the insurance business. In 1894 he became an investment broker and continued in the security business for a third of a century.

He was a former president of the Portland Board of Trade and had also served as president of the State Board. When the Chamber of Commerce was formed 20 years ago, he became a member of that body.

For many years he was a director of the Fidelity Trust Company, and he had been a director of the Federal Loan and Building Association from the time of its organization. He was a vice president of that association at the time of his death.

Mr. Flagg was a Republican and was a member of the Common Council in 1907, served as alderman for two terms, was president of the board for one term and had been considered as a possible mayor before the charter was changed. He also had served on the Maine Water Power Commission. Since the adoption of the

new city charter and the council manager form of government 12 years ago, Mr. Flagg has served as secretary of the Portland Civil Service Commission.

He was a Mason, a member of the Portland Club and the Episcopal Church.

Surviving are his wife who was Miss Edna F. Pressey of Rochester, N. H., a daughter, Mrs. Gwendolen F. Drew of Wellesley, Mass., and a son, Joseph P. Flagg of Portland, and a sister, Miss Nancy L. Flagg of Gloucester, Mass.
