Old Town, Jan. 29.—Vernon C. Flint, 72, one of Maine's most active Odd Fellows, died this morning in a Bangor hospital after a brief illness.

A past grand patriarch of the Grand Encampment of Maine, he was born at Detroit, Me., April 17, 1878, a son of William and Nancy Flint. He resided here since 1907 and worked as a millwright at the Penobscot Chemical Fibre Company, Great Works, until retiring in August, 1946.

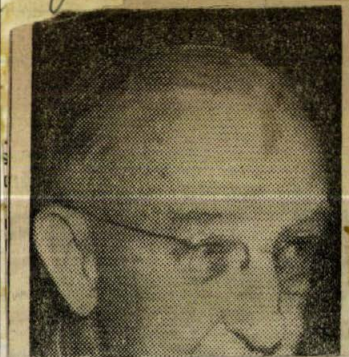

Chenery St., retired superintendent of Evergreen Cemetery and a distinguished Mason died here Wednesday.

One of two men in the nation to be named an honorary past grand commander of a grand commandery, Knights Templar, Floyd retired in 1943 after 51 years in the employ of the city at Evergreen Cemetery. For 30 years he assisted his father, Frank M. Floyd, cemetery superintendent, and later succeeded him in that position. In 1946 he was named a trustee of the cemetery.

His Masonic career was a long and active one. It began in 1893 when he was raised in Ancient Landmark Lodge here. He soon attained membership in other York Rite bodies and also was a 32nd Degree Mason.

He became secretary of Ancient Landmark Lodge in 1915. He was named treasurer of the Grand Commandery of Maine, Knights Templar, in 1922; treasurer of the Grand Chapter of Maine Royal Arch Masons, in 1925, and recorder of St. Alban Commandery KT, in 1931.

He served these several Masonic bodies until 1946 when he retired. He also served as commander of St. Alban Commandery in 1905. He and the late Convers E. Leach were named honorary past grand commanders of the Grand Commandery of Maine KT, in recognition of their many years of service. So far as could be determined, they were the only Sir Knights in the nation so honored.

A native of Portland, he attended local schools and specialized in accounting at Gray's Business College. He worked for two years as assistant bookkeeper with a shoe manufacturer then joined his father in the cemetery work.
