

Augusta, Dec. 13—(AP)—Sanford L. Fogg, Sr., 81, who retired in July, 1942, after serving seventeen years as Maine's deputy attorney general, died in his home here tonight.

The veteran Maine lawyer. whose son was elected mayor of Augusta Monday, was first named deputy attorney general to serve under Raymond Fellows of Bangor, now a superior court judge, and had served under five attorney generals.

He was born June 26, 1863, at Milan, N. H., and was educated at the Maine Weslevan Seminarv and at Bowdoin College. He served as a high school principal at Island Pond, Vt., before he began the study of law with Judge George A. Wilson at South Paris. He was superintendent of schools at South Paris. Beginning his practice at Rumford Falls, he later moved to Bath and served as city solicitor there, judge of the Bath Municipal Court, clerk of the Supreme Judicial Court for Sagadahoc County and as a member of the Bath city government.

Coming to Augusta to practice law in 1912, he served as the capital city's mayor from 1921 to 1923.

Besides his wife, the former Jessie K. Moody of Bath, whom he married in 1898, he leaves two sons, Mayor-elect Sanford L. Fogg, Jr., of Augusta and Ralph H. Fogg of Waterville, and a grandson. Blaine Viles Fogg.

He was active in Masonic circles and once served as grand commander of the Grand Commandery of Maine, Knights Templar. He was a Republican.




