Pittsfield, May 18—The Rev. Milo G. Folsom, 58, pastor of the Pittsfield Universalist Church, died today in Waterville, where he had been taken Sunday for a serious operation.

Mr. Folsom, one of the most widely known Universalist clergymen in New England, was born at West Stockholm, N. Y., the son of Mr. and Mrs. George L. Folsom. He received his education at Winthrop High School, St. Lawrence University, where he was graduated with an A. B. degree, and Canton, N. Y. Theological School, from which he was graduated in 1905. He was pastor of the Highstown, N. J., Church from 1912 to 1914, and the latter year he came to Portland to assume the pastorate of the Woodfords Universalist Church. While in that city he also served the church at South Windham.

From 1916 to 1927, he was pastor of the church in Gardiner, coming from that city to Pittsfield, where in addition to his church duties he had been keenly interested in every movement for civic betterment.

Mr. Folsom was a member of the Masonic bodies, the Order of the Eastern Star, Odd Fellows and Rebekahs, the Maine Universalist Sunday School Association, Maine Council of Religious Education, and served as president of the Mohawk Valley Ministers' Association, 1908-1912, secretary of the Kennebec Valley Ministerial Association, 1924-1927, and president of the Maine Universalist Convention from 1927 to 1929.

He leaves a wife, Mrs. Josephine B. Folsom, who is also an ordained minister, a son and a daughter.



South Paris, Feb. 25 — Arthur E. Forbes, 76, a country editor for 50 years who would never allow in his paper an item that would give offense or hurt anyone, and his wife, Mrs. Maud Dougias Forbes, 73, will be laid at rest side by side in the village cemetery here Monday afternoon.

Mr. Forbes died in Augusta this morning following a long illness, and two hours later the death of Mrs. Forbes occurred here. Funeral services for the couple will be conducted at the Huff funeral parlors at 2 p. m. and the community will pay fitting tribute to the couple.

Mr. Forbes was born in this town, the son of Elbridge and Angeline Thayer Forbes, attended the town schools and completed his education at St. Lawrence University, from which he was graduated in 1886.

Soon after he purchased the Oxford Democrat, one of the famous weeklies in this part of the State, and with George M. Atwood published the paper at Paris Hill, where the county offices were then located. When the county seat was established at South Paris, the Democrat moved here and Mr. Forbes continued to edit it until its merger with the Norway Advertiser a few years ago.

Mr. Forbes served in the Maine Legislature in 1919 and 1921, he was a past master of Paris Lodge of Masons and a past district deputy of the order, a past high priest of Oxford Chapter, Royal Arch Masons. and a past worthy patron of the Order of the Eastern Star. He was also affiliated with the Methodist Church.

Mrs. Forbes was born in Old Town and she was employed in the office of the Democrat for some years before her marriage to Mr. Forbes. She aided him in conducting the paper for a long time.

Mr. Forbes leaves several nieces and nephews and she leaves a brother, Harry Douglas of Winthrop, and two nieces.
