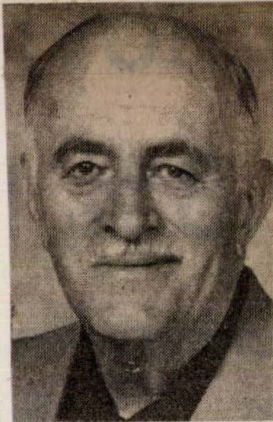
Arthur W. Ford, 72, of 104 Grandview Ave., Auburn, died unexpectedly at his home Friday.

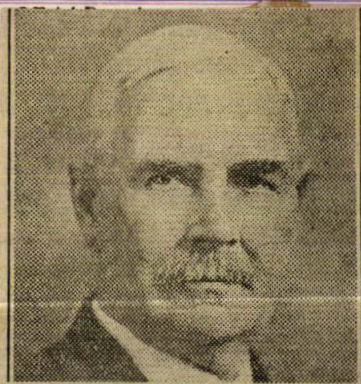

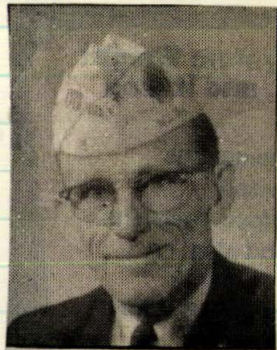
