





Former Mayor Ulysses E. Fosdick Dies At His Biddeford Home

Biddeford, Sept. 16—Former-Mayor Hysses Everett Fosdick, 78, retired husiness man, died today following in illness of several months.

Mr. Fosdick was a native of Alscad, N. H., the son of Andrew Jackson and Cornelia White Fosdick. He was a graduate of Rockland, Mass., High School.

When a young man he entered the employ of the Jordan Marsh Combany in Boston, where he was embloyed for some time before leaving to accept a position with the R. H. White Company. After being employed by the latter concern for about a year and a half, he accepted a position with the H. W. Robinson Company of Brockton, Mass, as a member of the sales staff and a short time later was made buyer.

He became a resident of Biddeford in 1908 and engaged in the dry and fancy goods business with the Smith-Fosdick Company. After being associated with the company for two years, he formed the Fosdick department store, first serving as treasurer of the company and later becoming president.

Mr. Fosdick, who was a Republican, was elected Mayor of Biddeford in 1921. Later he served as a member of the Biddeford Board of Education. He was a member of Dunlap Lodge, of Masons, the Royal Arch Chapter, Maine Council, Royal and Select Masters, and Bradford Commandery, Knights Templar. He was also active in Second Congregational Church circles.

He was twice married, his first wife being Kittie F. Webb, whom he married in Boston. His second wife was Susie M. Ewell, whom he married in Rockland, Mass. He leaves his wife and three children, Dorothy who resides in Boston, Effie of New York and Kittie Mcud of California.
