Mr. Foster held a commercial pilot's license and built his own plane and airport. He was a member of the Bowman Field Flying Club in Livermore Falls, the Aircraft Owner's Pilots Association, and the Experimental Aircraft Association of Sarasota, Fla.

He is survived by his wife, Marilyn (Reynolds) Foster of Wayne; one son, Charles R. Foster II of Sarasota, Fla.; two daughters, Sharon F. Bonney of Readfield and Mary F. Becker of Galesburg, Ill.; and two grandchildren.
