KENNEBUNKPORT — Thomas E. French, Jr., 87 years, a resident of Goose Rocks Road, Kennebunkport, ME and formerly of Rocky Hill, CT and Amherst, MA died Thursday, January 17th, 2002 at the Kennebunk Nursing Center after a brief illness.

Mr. French was born in East Hartford, CT on January 11, 1915, a son of Thomas E. and Claudia Cushman French, Sr. He graduated from Wethersfield CT High School.

Mr. French was employed by the Colt Industries of Hartford, CT as Supervisor and skilled metal polisher for ten years.

Mr. French was married to Georgia E. Perkins in 1948 in Springfield, MA. In the early 50's, Mr. and Mrs. French were co-owners of Lily Bay House and Cabins in Moosehead Lake, ME and then they moved back to Springfield, MA where he was employed by the Spaulding Sporting Goods in Chicopee, MA. Upon his retirement, he and his wife moved to Kennebunkport, ME in 1985.

He was a former member of the Grace Episcopal Church in Amherst where he and his wife were youth church leaders in the 60's and the 70's. He was a member and former deacon of the First Congregational Church of Kennebunkport, ME. Mr. French was a 63-year member and Past Master of the Stepney Lodge of Wethersfield and Rocky Hill, CT and member and chaplain of the Arundel Lodge 76 of Kennebunkport, ME. He served on the Zoning Board of Appeals of Kennebunkport for several years.

Mr. French was a former Certified Maine Guide. He was an avid gardener, fisherman, and all around outdoorsman.

Mr. French had just proudly completed four years in the pulmonary exercise program at UNE in Biddeford, ME.

He was predeceased by his twin brother and sister Howard and Hope French, a brother Paul French, and a sister Carol Signorelli.

Francis H. Friend, 60, Former State Senate President, Dies

SKOWHEGAN — Francis H. Friend, 60, a former president of the Maine State Senate, died at a Waterville hospital early Monday morning following a brief illness.

Friend was first elected to the house of representatives of the Maine State Legislature in 1929, serving three terms. He was elected to the State Senate in 1935, serving for ten years and was at one time president of that body.

He was active in the Skowhegan Fair and at one time was president of the fair association.

He had been in the lumber and pulpwood business since 1924.

Born in Skowhegan Feb. 17, 1898, he was the son of Howard B. and Lilla Murphy Friend and

was a lifelong resident of this town. He married the former Elisabeth Linekin, July 17, 1928, in Thomaston.

He was graduated from Skowhegan High School in the class of 1916, the University of Maine in 1920, and received his master's degree at Yale University in 1922.

Mr. Friend was a member of Kappa Sigma Fraternity and of the Senior Scholars at the University of Maine. He was also a member of the Maine Club, Peters Shortier Post, the American Legion, and Somerset Lodge A.F. and A.M.

He is survived by his widow and two daughters, Mrs. Margaret F. Olson, Waterville; Mrs. Helen F. Langlais of New York City; his mother, Mrs. Lilla B. Friend, Skowhegan; a sister, Mrs. Mary H. Friend, Skowhegan; two grandchildren, Cathleen and William Olson.
