

Orlando E. Frost Dies At Belfast

Belfast, July 30—Orlando E. Frost, 86, former Republican mayor of this city and president several years of the now defunct Belfast & Moosehead Lake Railroad, died suddenly at his home here this morning. The retired businessman had returned Sunday night from a trip to the White Mountains with his wife. He retired from both the positions of mayor and railroad president in 1926. He had served three terms as mayor. He also was a representative to the Legislature, declining to seek re-election.

Mr. Frost, a native of St. Albans in Somerset County, owned a garage business and Mathews' Brothers Corporation, manufacturers of building materials. He was born Dec. 14, 1864, and received his education in St. Albans schools and at the Maine Central Institute, Pittsfield.

When he was 15 years old, he left St. Albans for Worcester, Mass., where he worked 15 years for a wood working plant. He later traveled in New England and New York for a door manufacturing firm at Palatka, Fla. Six months later he went to Palatka to take charge of the plant, a post he held two years. He returned to Belfast to become general manager of the Mathews' Brothers Corporation. Ten years later he bought the business.

Philip K. Frye, 55, a lifelong resident of Portland and widely known commercial photographer, died suddenly in his home, 76 Portland Street, Monday evening. Death was due to heart trouble, with which he had been afflicted for some time.

Born in Portland, April 10, 1890, son of Mr. and Mrs. Isaiah Frye, Mr. Frye received his education in the public schools, including Portland High School. He worked as a drug clerk for a short time before engaging in photography in 1912, and in the intervening years developed an extensive trade. His work took him through Maine and other parts of New England. He photographed summer camp groups of boys and girls in this State, New Hampshire and Vermont, work which gained him special recognition. He was also widely known for his portrait work.

He was a 32nd degree Mason, a member of Ancient Landmark Lodge, Greenleaf Chapter, Portland Council, St. Alban's Commandery, Knights Templar; the Maine Consistory of the Scottish Rites, also of Kora Temple, Mystic Shrine. He was a member of the Portland Kiwanis Club, Woodfords Club, United Commercial Travelers, and the Executives Club.

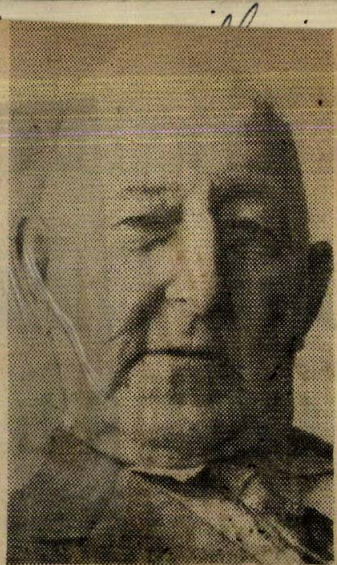

ROCKLAND—Elmer W. Fulton, 76, former superintendent of the Maine State Prison farm, died here Saturday. His career covered 33 years of service as a sheriff, police chief and state prison guard.

He was born Nov. 26, 1882, at Bridgewater, son of John and Nellie Hansel Fulton. He attended Bridgewater and Gardiner school and helped operate a farm with his father until 1929 when he became turnkey at the Aroostook County jail in Houlton under Sheriff John H. Welch.

In 1935 he became chief of police at Washburn, Aroostook County, and in 1937 moved to Warren where he was superintendent of the prison farm until 1945 when he became a prison guard.

Mr. Fulton retired from prison work in 1948 and in 1952 became night turnkey of Knox County Jail under Sheriff P. Willard Pease. He retired in June 1957.

He also was Knox County Humane agent.

Mr. Fulton was a member of the Aroostook Lodge of Masons and transferred later to the St. George Lodge of Masons, Warren. He was also a member of the Knox County Sheriffs Assn.
