SAMUEL BENSON FURBISH of Richmond, prominently identified with Masonic bodies, former treasurer of Bowdoin College, Brunswick town office holder and town manager at Dexter, died in a Boston Hospital this morning.

He was born in Brunswick, Aug. 1, 1874, was educated in the public schools there, and at Amherst College, from which he was graduated with Phi Beta Kappa honors in 1898. In 1901 he entered the office of the treasurer of Bowdoin College as assistant treasurer, and so continued until 1913, when he was made treasurer, and continued to hold that position some 15 years, when he was obliged to give up work because of ill health. Since that time he devoted most of his time to town offices being selectman and chairman of the Board of Assessors of the Town of Brunswick, afterwards manager of the Town of Dexter.

He was a great student of Masonry, giving much time and study to that fraternity. He became a Mason in United Lodge at Brunswick in 1902, and served his lodge as worshipful master in 1910 and 1911. He became a member of St. Paul's Chapter, in 1903, and was high priest in 1912 and 1913. He became a member of Mount Vernon Council, in 1903 and was its illustrious master in 1915 and 1916. He was Knighted in Dunlap Commandery of Knights Templar, Bath, in 1903 and served as commander in 1908. He received the 32nd degree in the

He was born here, the son of Harold and Sylvia Stanley Furbush.

He was a graduate of Hartland Academy, Hebron Academy, and the Suffolk Law School in Boston.

He was an attorney, insurance agent, farmer and lumberman and served as chairman of the Palmyra Board of Selectmen before being named legal counselor to the state's Office of Price Stabilization and director of the Maine OPS District in 1952.

Active in the Democratic Party, Forbush was appointed highway commissioner in 1958, a post which he held until 1964.

Wallace M. Gage, 86, died Oct. 13, 2004, at Penobscot Bay Medical Center, Rockport, after a brief illness.

While a student, he was part of the fire detail sent to Lakehurst N.J., to fight the fire when the Hindenburg crashed in 1937. As a Sea Scout, he was the first to receive the Quartermaster Award (similar to Eagle Scout in Boy Scouting) in New Hampshire, according to his family.

He began his career with Socony-Vacuum Oil Co. (now Exxon-Mobil Oil Corp.) in the Marine Transportation Department's U.S. tanker fleet, where he rose to first mate before being called to active duty in the U.S. Navy.

His naval service included placing the USS Saranac in commission, serving as first lieutenant, fire control officer and cargo officer. He served in the Pacific theater, servicing carrier and surface task forces at sea. He was later assigned to the New York State Maritime Academy in 1945, and retired from the Navy as a lieutenant commander, U.S. Navy Reserve, in 1978.

After, returning to Mobil, he served in the company's marine transportation organization.

Mr. Gage was a member of Ridge Church in Martinsville, serving as a deacon; Kinney-Melquist American Legion Post No. 34; Sons of the American Revolution; Retired Officers Association; U.S. Naval Institute; U.S. Navy Memorial Foundation; Scottish-American Military Society; council of Scottish Clan Association; and St. Andrew's Society of Maine, serving six years as governor. He was treasurer of the St. George Town Republican Committee, and former president of Seaside Cemetery Association.

An active Mason, he was raised in Mineola (NY) Lodge No. 985, was affiliated with Harmony Lodge No. 67 in New Canaan, Conn.; and Atlas Lodge No. 125 in Westfield, N.J., and most recently with Eureka Lodge No. 84 in Tenants Harbor. He was a member of Scottish Rite, Valley of Rockland, Portland Consistory, Kora Temple in Lewiston, Put Stevens Court, Royal Order of Jesters Club and the Mid-Coast Shrine Club.

His interest in Masonic history led him to write many articles for publication including "The Trinity Templar," "Fish, Ships and Quarry Chips," "The Mason's Mark," and many articles for The Maine Mason, official publication of the Grand Lodge of Maine.

Mr. Gage also served Grand Lodge as Grand Steward, was Grand Historian from 1987 to 1999, and served on several committees. He was most proud of having been elected to receive his 33rd Degree in 1993.
