Mr. Gallant's was one of the first new businesses to move into the not yet revitalized Old Port neighborhood.



"It was an untested neighborhood," said Joseph Meehan III, his son-in-law and current company president. "While he was cautious, he was always willing to undertake new ideas, such as Universal Check and the Lion Craft businesses. From the start they were successful operations."

The 104 Middle address served as Casco Printing's headquarters for 25 years. In 1986 the company moved to Bradley Street, Westbrook, to make way for the 100 Middle Street office complex.

Since retiring in 1980, Mr. Gallant served as chairman of the board of Casco Printing and he frequented the Cumberland Club on High Street.

SOUTHPORT - Weston E. Gamage Jr., 78, of Southport, a career Coast Guardsman who turned to community service in retirement, died March 20 in Manatee Memorial Hospital, Florida.

He was born in Southport, a son of Weston E. and Estelle Rand Gamage Sr., and attended local schools. For 26 years, Mr. Gamage served in the Coast Guard and retired as a chief boatswain's mate. His last duty station was Portland Head Light.

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

After he retired, Mr.

Gamage trapped lobsterers for a while and taught his children how to do the work. His daughter, Julie, appeared on the television show "What's My Line" in 1971, when she was 9, as the youngest licensed lobstererman in the county.

As he settled back into his hometown, he saw people from the very young to the elderly in need of help, according to his wife, Carolyn L. Gamage.

"I don't think he knew there was that need until he came back and got involved," Mrs. Gamage said. "He was just a very caring person. He had a lot of compassion."

Mr. Gamage was one of the founders and a board member of the Jessie Albert Dental Clinic, which provided dental care for disadvantaged children. He also informally helped children by setting up appointments and driving them to meet with specialists, Mrs. Gamage said.

Mr. Gamage was a member of Boothbay Baptist Church, a 33-year member of the Rockland Lodge, a commander of the Charles E. Sherman American Legion Post and a commander on the county level. Surviving are his wife, Carolyn L. Gamage; two daughters, Debra J. Morrill of Orrington and Julie A. Gamage of Manchester, N.H.; two sons, David A. of Wilton and Gerald L. of Southport; two sisters, Marjorie Bernier of Farmington and Jean Hoak of Pittston; and six grandchildren.

A memorial service will be held at 3 p.m. April 14 in Boothbay Baptist Church. The Rev. J. Daniel McNutt will officiate.

He also volunteered for Meals on Wheels, worked with the hospital's chaplain and set up his own service to help winterize the homes of the elderly, she said. "The people were just so starved for someone to talk to, someone to care, that oftentimes there was more talk than work," she said. "He sometimes had to go back again just to do the work."

Many people wrote Mrs. Gamage after Mr. Gamage's death, telling her that her husband found work for them or provided them a good recommendation for a job interview. He helped many find work by setting them up with the owners of summer cottages. Some of Julie Gamage's friends from college were able to earn extra money helping to open or close the cottages or doing odd jobs such as painting.

Mrs. Gamage said her husband's activities tied up a lot of his time, but he enjoyed helping others. "He got a great deal of satisfaction from it," she said. Although at times the need seemed so great that Mr. Gamage felt overwhelmed, "he always saw it as a challenge," she said.

Mr. Gamage also served on the school board, board of selectmen, planning board and cemetery committee, and was registrar of voters and a member of the Fire Department. He also was involved with Coastal Economic Development.
