
Mr. Gallagher belonged to the Maine Teachers Association, National Education Association, New England School Superintendents Association and the American Association of School Administrators.



Mr. Gallant's was one of the first new businesses to move into the not yet revitalized Old Port neighborhood.

Since retiring in 1980, Mr. Gallant served as chairman of the board of Casco Printing and he frequented the Cumberland Club on High Street.


- G. Merle Gammon, 100, died Monday at the Franklin Memorial Hospital in Farmington where he has been a patient since September of 1981.


