Farmington, Sept. 20.—Roy F. Gammon, 67, vice president and director of the Peoples National Bank died today at his home following a short illness. Mr. Gammon had been ill several weeks but his condition was not considered serious.

Banks, stores and business houses here will be closed between 2 and 3 p. m. Monday afternoon during funeral services for one of the town's most prominent citizens.

Born at West Farmington Jan. 21, 1880 the son of Albert F. and Elizabeth Ellis Gammon he attended the schools there and was graduated from Farmington High School, and from Farmington State Normal School in 1899.

He began his business career with the Rice & Paine Dry Goods Company and during that time became associated with the Peoples National Bank.

In 1906 he married Miss Irene P. Ladd and in 1910 with their two daughters they moved to Boston where he was treasurer of the Atkinson Furniture Company many years.

The family returned to Farmington in 1923, where Mr. Gammon entered the furniture business. He later resumed his bank association.

He was a Mason and a member of Jephthah Council, Pilgrim Commandery and the Masonic Club all of Farmington and of Kora Temple Shrine of Lewiston.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Irene L. Gammon; two daughters, Mrs. Drew T. Stearns and Mrs. James P. Flint; two grandchildren, Drew T. Stearns, jr., and Linda Irene Flint, all of Farmington.

DOVER-FOXCROFT - Thomas Grovener Gammon, 92, husband of Dora Hope (Trueworthy) Gammon, died Jan. 29, 2000, at a Dover-Foxcroft nursing home. He was born May 5, 1907, in Old Town, the son of Nathaniel H.A. and Margaret (Kirkpatrick) Gammon.
