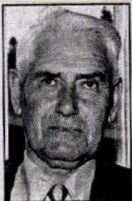

He was a former member and secretary and the American College of Mortgage Attorneys and a Fellow of the American College of Probate Counsel and was a member of the Fee Arbitration Commission of the Maine Board of Overseers of the Bar. On May 31, 1941, he married Phyllis Ann Chapman. For many years he was a director and general counsel for the Federal Loan and Building Association of Portland. Since 1962, he had been a director of York Mutual Insurance Co. of Maine and had served as it's chairman of the board as well as chairman of the board of York Insurance Co. and York Holding Co.. Mr. Gardner had been secretary and a member of the Civil Service Commission of the City of Portland from 1961-1964. For many years he was a member of the Advisory Board of the Salvation Army of Greater Portland, serving as it's chairman from 1982-1984. He was also a member and past president of the Woodfords Club, member of the Portland Country Club and enjoyed reading. A member of the Woodfords Church of Portland, he served as a member of the Governing Board and was a trustee of the Invested Fund and it's former chairman. On June 15, 1944 he was raised a Master Mason in Ancient Landmark Lodge No. 17 and served as Worshipful Master in 1955. In the Grand Lodge of Maine, he served as Disitric Deputy Grand Master, Grand Marshall, Grand Senior

Deacon, Grand Lecturer and Deputy Grand Master. He was elected Grand Master of Masons serving form 1966-1967. He was also on several committees of the Grand Lodge and was chairman of the Finance Committee and the committee on Masonic Jurisprudence, and had been a trustee of the Charitable Foundation since 1966 . Mr. Gardner was Exalted in Greenleaf Chapter No. 13 in 1960, greeted in Portland Council in 1961, and knighted in Portland Commandery in 1960. He was a member and past officer in Maine Conclave No. 1, Knights of the Red Cross of Constantine, member of Maine Lodge of Research, Maine College of Societies Rosicrucians and Kora Temple A.A.O.N.M.S.. He was a member of the Commission on Information for Recognition of the Conference of Grand Masters of North America for 6 years and it's former chairman. Ill. Brother Donald Gardner completed his Scottish Rite degrees in Maine Consistory in 1951.
