BANGOR — John Jacob Gass died July 21, 1985, in Mariaville as the result of a boating accident. He was born in Bangor, March 5, 1924, the son of Jacob and Anna Mary (Stone) Gass. John, better known as "Buddy," owned and operated the New Essex Variety Store until 1970. He worked as a pharmacist at the Post Office Pharmacy in Bangor until he became State Pharmacy Inspector in 1977. His work took him throughout the state, where he was well-known and respected. He became active in city politics during the early 1970s, when he worked for the concept of an elected school board. During the years that he served on the City Council, he gained much admiration and respect for his awareness and adamant support of the needs of the people of Bangor. He was a member of the Congregation Beth Abraham of Bangor, a U.S. Army veteran of World War II, a member of Maine Pharmaceutical Association, Rising Virtue Lodge No. 10, AF & AM, of

Bangor; the Scottish Rite Bodies, Valley of Bangor; Maine Consistory, 32nd Degree of Portland; Bangor-Brewer Shrine Club and Anah Temple Shrine. Surviving besides his wife, Ethelyn (Pullen) Gass of Bangor, are a daughter, Mrs. Ronald (Mari Ann) Reed; a son, Stephen Gass, both of Kenduskeag; three grandsons; one brother, Julius Gass of Florida; three sisters, Rena Gass of Bangor, Dottie Zitomer and Frances Garner, both of Maryland; several nieces, nephews and cousins. Funeral services will be held 12 noon Wednesday at the Jewish Funeral Chapel, Center Street, Bangor, with Rabbi Henry Isaacs of the Congregation Beth Abraham officiating. Robert S. Gass, a retired utilities executive, died Saturday at a local nursing home.

Mr. Gass, who had lived both at 122 Portland St. and 327 Summit St., was 91.

He was born in Tatamagouche, Nova Scotia, the son of Sidney and Fannie Henderson Gass.

He served as executive director of the Order of DeMolay of Maine. With the Masons, he served as High Priest, Illustrious Master, Commander, and Most Piusant Sovereign of the Red Cross of Constantine.



In May 1965, Mr. Gass received the Greenleaf Medal for his devotion to the Masons, and his contribution to the advancement of the Order of DeMolay.

He was conferred the Royal Order of Scotland, and for 20 years served as Chaplain of Kora Shrine Temple in Lewiston.

In addition to fraternal activities, he was interested in gardening.

"He liked organic gardening," said Rita Rumrill of Portland, a niece. "He had about five acres of land at the Summit Street house, and he had wonderful flowers and vegetables.

"He raised hens at one time, and kept nine to 12 hives going for the making of honey."

Mr. Gass, who served in the Army during World War II, also enjoyed carpentry and travel.

His niece recalled that he maintained his good nature well into his older years.

In 1983, for instance, he won a coupon drawing at a Baskin-Robbins ice cream store that entitled him to a free bicycle. Mr. Gass, who was then 81, not only came to collect the bike but rode it out of the store.

"He was lots of fun, and always had a twinkle in his eye," his niece said.

His wife, Harriett Cobb Gass, died in 1991.

Also surviving are two other nieces, Carol Langben of Bath and Jane Henderson of Ipswich, Mass.; and a great-nephew, Robert Rumrill of Boston.

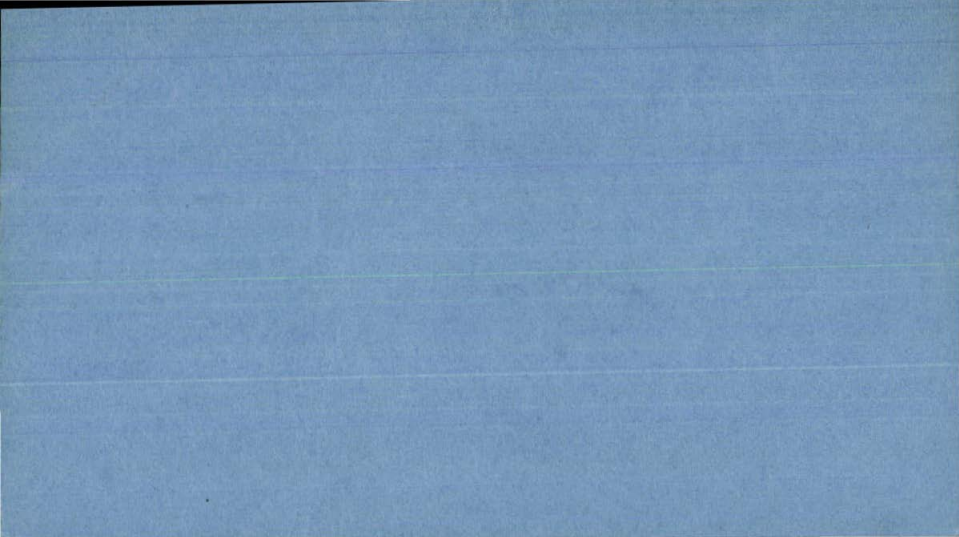

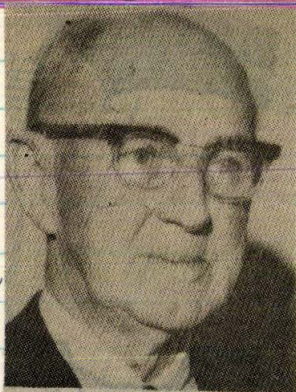
