

"He was lots of fun, and always had a twinkle in his eye," his niece said.

His wife, Harriett Cobb Gass, died in 1991.

Also surviving are two other nieces, Carol Langben of Bath and Jane Henderson of Ipswich, Mass.; and a great-nephew, Robert Rumrill of Boston.






