Dr. Edwin W. Gehring, 77, died in his sleep Friday night at his home on 284 Ocean Avenue.

He was born in Cleveland, O., the son of August H. and Katherine Wagner Gehring, and had practiced medicine in Portland for more than 50 years.

Prominent in Maine medical circles he was past president of the Maine Medical Association, the Cumberland County Medical Association and the Portland Medical Society, and was a member of the Board of Governors of the American College of Physicians for 12 years.
