Marshall J. Gerrie Sr.

hospital co-founder, trained retrievers

WATERVILLE — Dr. Marshall J. Gerrie Sr., the last surviving founder of what now is known as Inland Hospital, died Friday in the hospital he helped found in 1943. He was 80.

Dr. Gerrie was born in Boston on Oct. 20, 1916, the only son of Lewis and Isabelle Gerrie, and grew up in North

Adams, Mass. He received his medical training at Massachusetts Osteopathic Hospital, Massachusetts General Hospital, Boston City Hospital, Philadelphia's College of Osteopathic Medicine and other institutions.

In 1943, Dr. Gerrie and Dr. E.G. Drew founded Waterville Osteopathic Hospital. "They used some of their own money to buy the first hospital building and borrowed the rest," Dr. Gerrie's wife, Patricia A. Gerrie said.

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

Both men saw the need for an osteopathic hospital, she said, where they and other osteopathic physicians could admit and treat their own patients. The first hospital building was on Western Avenue. The hospital moved to its current site on Kennedy Memorial Drive in 1962. Last year, the name was changed to Inland Hospital.

Dr. Gerrie completed a five-year fellowship in general surgery at Waterville Osteopathic Hospital in 1948 and was board certified in general surgery in 1964. He was in general practice in Pittsfield from 1940 to 1943 and practiced general surgery in Pittsfield and Waterville from 1943 to 1983.

Even before retiring in 1986, Dr. Gerrie and his wife had begun raising and training championship Labrador retrievers. Mrs. Gerrie said her husband had an "all-consuming interest" in training Labradors for competitive field trials. With professional handlers and guidance from the Gerries, the couple's dogs competed on the East Coast as well as in California and Canada.

Dr. Gerrie served as a trustee of Unity College and Oak-Grove Coburn School. He was a 32nd degree Mason and a member of the Masonic Meridian Lodge in Pittsfield.

Survivors include his wife of 23 years, Patricia A. Gerrie of Waterville; two sons, Dr. Marshall J. Jr. of Waterville and Stephen J. Gerrie of St. Louis, Mo.; seven grandchildren and four great-grandchildren. He was predeceased by his first wife, Mary M. Gerrie, and his daughter, Glenda J. Walker.

A memorial service will be held at 11 a.m. Monday at St. Mark's Episcopal Church on Eustis Parkway in Waterville.

Loen W. Gerrish, former superintendent of South Portland Schools, died early Sunday morning at his home, 93 Mitchell Road, at the age of 74 years.

His teaching and administrative career in Maine schools covered a span of 44 years, completed in October, 1931, when he was retired as one of the oldest living superintendents in the State.

Born in Brownville, Dec. 17, 1868, he was the son of Hiram and Laura Clark Gerrish. He was graduated from Bates College in 1888.

Before coming to South Portland in the Spring of 1925, he had taught school at Milltown and served as superintendent of schools in Caribou, Skowhegan and Gardiner.

Among his other activities, he was prominent throughout the State as a 32nd Degree Mason and a member of the IOOF, holding high office in both organizations.

His wife, the former Caroline Powers, died in May, 1940.

Surviving are a brother, Hiram Gerrish of Brownville; a half sister, Mrs. Ada Tuffts of Brownville Junction; and five nephews, Earl Gerrish of Brownville, Judson Gerrish of Milo, Henry Gerrish of Dover-Foxcroft, Harland Atherton of Goffstown, N. H., and Wendell Gerrish of Bangor, now stationed with the Army Air Force in Texas.

Funeral services will be held at 10 a. m. today at the funeral home of George J. Henry, 160 Ocean Street, South Portland, with the Rev. Ray Stevenson, pastor of the People's Church officiating. Interment will be in Brownville where another service will be held Tuesday from the Methodist Church.

UNITY — Philip Louis Gervais, 82, of the Bangor Road, died Saturday, April 14, 2001, at his home following a long illness.

He was born Nov. 29, 1918, in Waterville, son of Arthur and Amanda (Veilleux) Gervais. He attended Waterville schools and joined the U.S. Navy, serving seven years aboard the USS Alabama and the USS Texas before and during World War II.

He returned to Waterville in 1946, where he owned and operated a refrigeration and air conditioning business, Gervais Refrigeration.

He married Ruth Parks in 1947.

In 1956 he moved to St. Charles, Ill., where he worked for one year for Carrier Refrigeration and then opened his own refrigeration and air conditioning business. He retired to Unity in 1990.

He was always interested in civic affairs, serving on many committees.

While in Warner, N.H., he served for three years as a town selectman and, especially enjoyed working on floats commemorating both the nation's and the town's bicentennial.

He was a 59-year member of Masonry, joining in Warner on his birthday in 1941. He was past master of Harris Lodge No. 91 in Warner and Star In The West Lodge No. 85 in Unity. He was a member of the Vesta Chapter No. 49 OES in Warner and Josiah H. Drummond Chapter No. 91 in Unity. He was a member and past commander of the Benjamin Berry Post No. 50 American Legion in Unity. He was an active member of the United Church of Warner and the Unity Union Church in Unity.

Phil was president of Refrigeration Service Engineers Society, which he helped reactivate in Aurora, Ill. While in Illinois, Phil led the national campaign for removing doors from refrigerators for child safety. He taught refrigeration and air conditioning at the Vocational Technical College at Manchester, N.H. He wrote many articles for engineering magazines and at the time of his death was writing a textbook on refrigeration troubleshooting. He had written several articles for the Waterville Morning Sentinel concerning his experiences while in the U.S. Navy during World War II. Phil enjoyed painting and working on all things mechanical. One of his outstanding traits was his ever-present optimism.

Survivors include his wife of 53 years, Ruth (Parks) Gervais, of Unity; his children, Betty L. and Gloria J. Gervais, both of Unity; and one son, James L. Gervais, of Carolina Beach, N.C.; three brothers, Roland, of Gardiner, Alphonse, of Waterville, and Fred, of Norridgewock; three sisters, Theresa Baiera and Irene Morrisette, both of Niagara Falls, N.Y., and Shirley Morreale, of Succasunna, N.J.; many nieces and nephews.

Besides his parents, he was predeceased by four brothers, Norman, Leonel, Fernand, and Reginald, and two sisters, Jeannette Labrie and Annette Gervais.

Friends may call from 6 to 8 p.m. Monday, April 16. A Masonic service will be at 7 p.m. at Lawry Brothers Funeral Home, Depot Street, Unity.

A funeral will be at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday, April 17, at Unity Union Church. Burial will be later at West Sidney Cemetery.
