John William "Bud" Gibson, 83, died peacefully at his home on Friday, June 6, 2003. He was born in Allagash, Feb. 16, 1920, the son of Samuel and Esther (Hafford) Gibson.

John loved God, his family, his church, nature, lemon pie and the New York Yankees. He attended Allagash schools and graduated from Fort Kent High School in 1953. During World War II, John served in the Atlantic and Pacific theaters, and was a member of the Kamikaze Survivors Association. John married Vera Gardner who predeceased him in 1966. On April 12, 1969, he married Elsie (Parker) Libby. They enjoyed hunting, fishing and canoeing in the northern Maine woods. John was a life member and past Master of the Fort Kent Masonic Lodge. He was a registered Maine guide and a licensed surveyor. He was a former Deacon at the Ashland Advent Christian Church. John was very active in local government, having served as First Selectman for both Allagash and Nashville Plantation. Work was an important part of John's life. As a young man he worked as a woodsman and ranger in the northern Maine woods. He worked for the Maine Forestry Service from 1946-1959 and as assistant scaler for Pingree Timberlands from 1953-1959. In 1959 he became the Land Agent for Seven Islands/Pingree Timberlands, Ashland District. He worked in that capacity until his retirement in 1982. He was proud of his work for the company and when he retired he wrote, "I believe future generations will benefit from the company's belief in the future of the woodlands and their planning for the future." John was well known for his knowledge of the northern Maine woods and the Native Americans of the area. One of his hobbies was scouting for Native American relics and was instrumental in the location of several burial sites. The Maine author Lew Dietz published several pieces about his canoeing exploits with Bud and his friend John Sinclair. John's retirement years were filled with taking care of his farm in Nashville Plantation, guiding at the Libby Sporting Camps and spending time with his children and grandchildren.

He will be deeply missed by his wife, Elsie Gibson of Nashville Plantation; two daughters, Gail Gibson of Mapleton, and Mary Caron and her husband, Randy, of Garfield Plantation; four stepsons, Gary Libby of Wadsworth, Ohio, Tyler Libby and his wife, Debbie, of Stratham, N.H.; Sam Libby and his wife, Siony, of Jacksonville, Fla.; Matt Libby and Ellen of Ashland; eight grandchildren, Kelly Olcott and her husband, Jim, of Syracuse, N.Y., Ryan Caron and his wife, Lynn, of Standish, Kristina Caron of Portland, Alison Winslow and her husband, Tim, of Thomaston, Matt John Libby of Ashland, Jessica Hardy and Jason Libby of Jacksonville, Fla., Elizabeth and Sara Libby of Stratham, N.H.; Melissa Knutson of Northville, Mich.; one great-grandson, Caleb Hardy of Jacksonville, Fla.; two brothers, Albert and Dwight Gibson of Allagash; one sister, Viola Martin of Caribou; many nieces and nephews. In addition to his first wife, he was predeceased by two brothers, Calvin Hafford of Allagash, Samuel Gibson of Augusta; and one sister, Margaret Hafford of Presque Isle.

Relatives and friends may call at the Advent Christian Church, Exchange St., Ashland, 6:30-8:30 p.m. Saturday and from 1 p.m. until time of service on Sunday. A funeral service will be held at the church at 2 p.m. Sunday with Rev. Alan Chamberlin, pastor, officiating. Committal service and interment will be in the Allagash Municipal Cemetery at 5:30 p.m. Sunday. Those who wish may contribute in his memory to the Advent Christian Church of Ashland.
