George I. Gilbert

yacht captain, storyteller, Iwo Jima veteran

BRISTOL — George I. Gilbert, 72, a yacht captain who was known as an outstanding storyteller, died Monday at Maine Medical Center, Portland, after a long illness.

For most of his life, Mr. Gilbert was an engineer and captain on pleasure motor yachts. He had recently worked as yacht captain for Fred Schaefer, owner of

Schaefer Marine Hardware Corp. He had also worked for several other wealthy families that summered in the Pemaquid area.

Mr. Gilbert's job took him south during the winter months to the Bahamas, Florida and the Caribbean, and he kept a winter home in West Palm Beach for many years.

"He was a worldly guy," said his nephew, Wayne Gilbert. "He went first as engineer and finally became captain.

He not only ran motor

yachts but he ran a sailboat for a fellow for about five or six years. Of the two he enjoyed sailing the best."

Mr. Gilbert served during World War II with the 3rd Marine Division and he participated in the invasion of the islands of Guam and Iwo Jima.

He was known to his friends and family as an outstanding storyteller, and many of his stories involved his war and seafaring experiences.

"He was a perfect storyteller," said his nephew. "If you had a group of people in a room, it usually went quiet when he was telling a story. He talked about things that happened over his lifetime, from back during World War II right up until just recently.

"He talked about the volcanic ash on Iwo Jima," said his nephew, "and what it was like to try and make your way through that. He talked about being in a foxhole for three days straight and not knowing if you were going to see the next day, and how they'd hear all these noises at night and how the Japanese were everywhere on the island."

"He had a million stories," said Tom Baker, a longtime friend who served in the Marines with Mr. Gilbert. "He was very dry. He could have been a famous Maine storyteller if he wanted."

"George was my longest and best friend," said Baker. "He introduced my wife to me. We celebrated our 50th wedding anniversary with him in Maine."

Mr. Gilbert himself was never married. "He enjoyed the freedom and he loved the boats and the sea too much," said Baker.

Born here, a son of George I. and Leah Fossett Gilbert, he graduated from Lincoln Academy, Newcastle, and attended the University of Maine and Northeastern University. After the war, he worked for a while at Pratt & Whitney Aircraft Corp. in Connecticut.

He was a member of Masons, the Veterans of Foreign Wars and the 3rd Marine Division Association.

Surviving are two brothers, Walker of Windsor and Manley of New Harbor; three sisters, Thelma Huntley of Damariscotta, Irma Tukey of Pemaquid and Arrollyn Graham of Niantic, Conn.; and several nieces and nephews.

He had been a practising physician for 40 years, at Phippsburg, Franklin, Mass., and Litchfield. He was born in the latter community and practiced there 30 years. When he retired 23 years ago, he came to East Auburn to live.

Dr. Gilbert was the son of John C. and Olive Brann Gilbert, and he was graduated from Bowdoin College in 1874. He was a member of Morning Star Lodge of Masons at Litchfield, Mount Olivet Chapter of OES in Auburn, and the Litchfield Baptist Church. His widow, Sarah E. DR. LEWIS SMITH GILFILLAN

1918-2007

AUGUSTA — Dr. Lewis Smith Gilfillan, 88, died Sunday, Sept. 16, 2007, at the Maine Veterans Home in Augusta after a long illness.



Dr. Gilfillan was born Dec. 24, 1918, in Skowhegan, to the late James and Edith (Nutting) Gilfillan. He and his family lived in Bar Harbor where he graduated from Mount Desert High School.

Dr. Gilfillan received his undergraduate and DMD degree from Tufts University in 1940. He completed his internship and residency in oral surgery at the University Of Cincinnati Hospitals in Ohio. He joined the Public Health Service and served the Coast Guard during World War II. Stationed in San Francisco, he was assigned to the Navy ship, the General H B Freeman, which sailed the Pacific, and attained the rank of senior assistant/dental surgeon.

Dr. Gilfillan returned to Maine after his honorable discharge from the Coast Guard on Aug. 12, 1946, and began his career as an oral surgeon, first in Portland and later in Augusta where he opened his private practice. During this time he was also involved in establishing and subsequently teaching at the Dental Hygienist Program at Westbrook Junior College. In addition to practicing at the VA Hospital at Togus, he had a clinical appointment from Harvard University Dental School to teach their dental students and residents at Togus.

After he retired from dentistry in 1986, he continued to enjoy his love of the outdoors by working in his garden, tending his fruit trees, boating, fishing and cross-country skiing at his home in Sidney.

Dr. Gilfillan was a member of the South Parish Congregational Church of Augusta and the Masonic Lodge, also of Augusta. He had been active in the Au-

gusta Country Club and the Kiwanis Club of Augusta. He was also a member of the American Dental Association, the Maine Dental Association and the Kennebec Valley Dental Society.

The family wishes to thank the very dedicated and skilled staff at the Maine Veterans Home for their compassion, care, and support.

Dr. Gilfillan is survived by his wife, Wanda Womack Gilfillan, of Augusta; his son, William L. Gilfillan, his wife, Christine, and their daughter, Kathleen Connelly, all of Brewer; his daughter, Dr. Carol A. Gilfillan, her husband, Dr. Joseph E. Simon, of Amelia Island, Fla., and their children, Jennifer A. Simon and her husband, James Shilkett, of Chicago, and Eric J. Simon of Stanford, Calif.; a brother, Robert Gilfillan and his wife, Barbara, of Bar Harbor; and three nieces, a nephew and their families.

A celebration of Dr. Gilfillan's life will be held at 2 p.m. Saturday, Sept. 22, at the South Parish Congregational Church, United Church of Christ, with the Rev. Bruce Forbes and pastor Richard Kimball, of the Sixth Street Congregational Church in New Auburn, officiating. A private interment will be held at the new Maine Veterans Memorial Cemetery on Mount Vernon Road in Augusta.

Kittery, Feb. 20—Robert J. Gilker, 62, master rigger and laborer at the Kittery Navy Yard, died this afternoon at the Portsmouth Hospital, where he was taken last month following a paralytic stroke. Death was due to pneumonia.

Mr. Gilker was a native of New Carlisle, P. Q., and became a resident of Bath when a youth. In 1893 he entered the employ of the Bath Iron Works as a ship fitter's helper and he remained there until 1901, when he went to Groton, Conn., to work for the Electric Boat Company.

Two years later he returned to Bath to accept the position of foreman ship fitter, which he held for nine years, before resigning to take a position in Seattle, Wash. Three years after this, he was named as foreman of the laborers' and riggers' department at the local yard and later was made master.

He was a 32nd degree Mason, being a member of Solar Lodge in Bath, a Shriner and a member of Portsmouth Lodge of Elks.

Surviving are two sons, Robert J. Gilker, Jr., of Portsmouth and Arthur S. of New York, and a daughter, Mrs. John W. Howe of Portsmouth. Funeral services will be conducted Wednesday at 3 p. m., at the Buckminster chapel.
