Robert Goodwin, remembered as a 'people person'

NORWAY — Robert W. Goodwin, a "people person" who took pride in his hometown and became involved in the community, died April 9, 2000. He was 86.

Born here, a son of Stuart W. Goodwin and Margaret Stearns Goodwin, he graduated from Norway High

School in 1932, playing on its Western Maine championship basketball team. He graduated from Duke University in 1936, where he was a member of Delta Tau Delta fraternity. He was an enthusiastic supporter of Duke basketball throughout his life.

After his graduation, and a short time in Boston and New York gaining insurance business experience, he returned to Norway to join his father in the local insurance agency, Good-

win's Inc. Insurance. He remained for more than 60 years, interrupted only by service in the Navy as an officer in the Pacific during World War II.

Mr. Goodwin's heart belonged to Norway, his family said. He took great pride in serving the community and sharing in the daily life of its residents.

He was elected to one term as Oxford County treasurer and was named the Chamber of Commerce's second annual citizen of the year. He was president of the Norway Board of Trade, Sanborn Shoe Corp. and the Norway Pine Grove Cemetery Association. He also was a director of the Norway National Bank.

Mr. Goodwin was a 60-year member and past president of the Norway/Pine Grove Club and the Oxford Masonic Lodge of Norway, and a longtime member of the American Legion. He chaired fund-raising drives for the Norway Universalist Church, Stephens Memorial Hospital and the Masonic Building Fund.

Mr. Goodwin loved interacting with those around him. In semi-retirement, his son Stuart Goodwin said, he still enjoyed going to the insurance office often during the week to talk with people. "He loved meeting with new people as well as old friends," his son recalled.

He enjoyed golf and the camaraderie it offered. When his father helped organize the Norway Country Club, he began his own association there by donating the new fairways of stones, and served with distinction as a young caddy master, his family said. He then served throughout his life on many of the club's governing committees.

Mr. Goodwin was married for more than 50 years to the former Eleanor Robinson of Oxford. Together they enjoyed traveling, especially to the golf links of Scotland.

He had planned to attend the 2000 British Open.

Mr. Goodwin was fascinated by cars and took great pride in his 1917 Buick.

Besides his wife of Norway, he is survived by two sons, Stuart W. of Norway and Philip R. of New York City; a daughter, Alice M. Goodwin of Orono; a sister, Mrs. Janet Carriek of New Bern, N.C.; a niece, Jane Goodwin of Gloucester, Mass.; and a nephew, Col. William Goodwin of Georgia.



He had always worked in the investment field, starting out as a bond salesman in New York. Coming to Portland several years prior to the World War. Early in the 1920's he became affiliated with the New York investment house of Brandon, Gordon and Waddell as a partner and in 1927 formed his own firm of Alexander Gordon and Company with headquarters in Portland and branches in Boston and New York. He conducted a general business in municipal and utility bonds and was known as a specialist in such investments. Since 1934 he had been affiliated with the municipal department of F. S. Moseley & Company of Boston but maintained his home in Portland.

Before the United States joined the Allies in the World War, Mr. Gordon dropped his bond selling activities in Portland and went to New York City where he enlisted in the Gordon Highlanders. Previously, while a young man in New York City, he was a member of the old Seventh Regiment of New York.

Transferred to Halifax to begin training for a commission in the English army, he was in that city when the explosion of a munitions ship in the harbor rocked the city leveled most of the buildings and killed thousands. He remained with his regiment and eventually was commissioned a second lieutenant in the British Army and served overseas.

He was born in Orange, N. J., Nov. 8, 1886 and was educated in the public schools there. He came to Portland in 1911 and made his home here since although traveling frequently throughout New England.

He was a 32nd Degree Mason, of Kora Temple of the Shrine and various other Masonic bodies. He also was a member of the Portland Club, the Bond Club of Maine and the Municipal Bond Club of Massachusetts.

He is survived by his wife, Elizabeth Payson Gordon; three sons, Alexander, Jr., Payson and Bruce Gordon; three brothers, William of Denver, Colo.; James B. and Thomas Gordon of New Jersey; and two sisters, Mrs. Edward Dinsmore and Mrs. William Simpson, also of New
