

The service followed a parade of Legionnaires and a delegation from Arion Lodge of Masons, of which Sergeant Goodwin was a member.




Fred T. Googins Sr., 85, of 97 Fessenden St., a retired builder and contractor, died Sunday afternoon at his residence following a brief illness.






