Donald A. "Sonny" Goss, 71, of Oakley Street died Saturday in a Portland hospital following an illness with cancer.

He was born in Lewiston, a son of Arthur P. and Ruth Osborn Goss, and attended Mechanic Falls schools. He was a graduate of Mechanic Falls High School.

Mr. Goss was retired from the Air Force and Superior Court for Cumberland County. He later founded Goss Mimeograph Co., currently known as Goss Davis Service.

He was a member of Trinity Episcopal Church.

He was a member of the masons in Portland and Mechanic Falls, Kora Shrine in Lewiston, Scottish Rite Bodies Valley of Portland, the Fraternal Order of Eagles, the National Association for Uniformed Services and a life member of the Cutterman's Association.

He was a private pilot and was a lieutenant with the

Civil Air Patrol. He also sailed on Casco Bay.

Surviving are his wife of 50 years, Pauline Blyth Goss of Portland; a daughter, Jennifer Goss-Godsoe of Cumberland; a sister, Shirley Strickland of Mechanic Falls; and two grandchildren, Heather Godsoe and Jonathan Godsoe, both of Cumberland.

There will be no visiting hours. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Tuesday at Trinity Episcopal Church, Coyle Street and Forest Avenue. EWISTON, April 23. (Special)—
Edwin L. Goss, 72, of 60 Wood
Street, well known Lewiston businessman, died this morning at the Central
Maine General Hospital in this city
as the result of injuries received at
5.30 Sunday night when he was struck
down by a taxicab at Main and Blake
Streets. He suffered a fracture of the
skull and death was due to cerebral
hemorrhage.

Joseph Dobell of Rideout Street was driver of the taxi.

Mr. Goss for many years had been engaged in business in this city, long being associated with the firm of A. L. & E. F. Goss, crockery dealers, before becoming connected with the Bradford Conant Co. five years ago. He was prominent in the work of the United Baptist Church of this city and was on his way to the church when struck. He was treasurer of one of the Masonic badies in this city.

Besides his second wife, Mrs. Cella Goss, a church organist here, he leaves a daughter by a former marriage, Mrs. Ernest Ham of Wales, and a brother, George B. Goss of 365 Turner Street, Auburn. Another brother, George Goss, long cashier of the First National Bank, died some time ago.







Lewiston, July 8—John Burgess
Goss, 68, of Russell Street, Lewiston
died Tuesday morning at the Central Maine General Hospital. Mr.
Goss had been in poor health for
some time.

A native of this city, Mr. Goss was born March 22, 1871, the son of John and Mary Brooks Goss, and with the exception of three years

spent in Bangor, about 1900, had always resided in Lewiston. For many years Mr. Goss was in the grocery business here, under the firm name of Howard and Goss, but of late had been employed at the Androscoggin mill.

He was prominent in local fraterral organizations, being a member of Rabboni lodge of Masons, a past master of the Scottish Rites, a past high priest of the King Hiram Chapter, a past patron of the order of Eastern Star, a member of Lewiston Lodge IOOF, a past patriarch of the Encampment, and a post noble grand of the old Golden Rule Lodge. Mr. Goss was also a member of the Royal Arcanum, and the Lewiston United Baptist Church of which he was a former deacon.

On Sept. 20, 1893, he married Alice M. Wyman, who survives as do a sister, Mrs. Cedelle Smith of West Haven, Conn.; two sons, Wyman Goss of Pittsfield, Mass., and John Goss of Auburn; two daughters, Mrs. Catherine Tarbell of Pittsfield, Mass., and Mrs. Herbert T. (Grace) Walker of Lewiston; ten grandchildren; and sev-

eral nieces and nephews.






