## Edward K. Gould, 74, **Rockland Attorney**, Dies

Special Despaten to The Press Herald Rockland, Nov. 13-Edward K. Gould, 74, prominent Rockland attorney, one of the three oldest members of the Knox County Bar and widely-known in Masonic fraternity of the State, died at his home tonight following a long illness.

Mr. Gould, a life-long resident of Rockland, had for many years been a leader in local and state affairs. He has served as State Historian. had twice been Mayor of the city. had been chairman of the Republican county committee; judge of the Knox County Probate Court, commissioner of deeds when records of Knox, Waldo and Lincoln Counties were revised: was director of National Archives Research for Maine, New Hampshire and Vermont since the beginning of this work in 1937, and had also served as county treasurer.


He was a member of the Antique Motorcycle and the Yankee Chapter Motorcycle clubs.
