Funeral services for Capt. Collins M. Gott, who died at his home here Tuesday, were held Thursday at the Hay and Peabody Funeral Home, conducted by the Rev. Ernest Thorsell, pastor of the First Universalist Church.

Captain Gott was born on Gott's Island, March 23, 1884, son of Erastus and Rachel Gott and attended school there. During his early manhood he was engaged in the fishing industry and yachting. He began his seafaring career before he reached the age of 20 and rose to a master mariner, possessing an unlimited Master's License in the U. S. Merchant Marine Service.

During World War I, he made numerous trips to foreign ports and made 17 trips on relief ships to Russia. His active seafaring life, during which he visited all

important world commercial ports, covered a period of 35 years. Later, he made several trips on large coast-wise merchant steamers and tankers along the Atlantic seaboard.

His immediate surviving relatives are three daughters, Mrs. Alma R. McIntosh and Mrs. Fannie E. Dyer of Chebeague Island, and Mrs. Hilda E. Sylvia of Calais; a sister, Phoebe E. Gott of McKinley; two brothers, Montelle Gott of Gott's Island and Berlin Gott of McKinley; six grandsons and three great-grandchildren.

He was a member of Tremont Lodges of Masons and Odd Fellows and of the National Organization of Masters, Mates and Pilots of America. Burial was in the family lot in the Chebeague Island Cemetery.

Although he had not been active in business for some years, he retained the presidency of the railroad he founded and which he sold to the Canadian Pacific Railroad nearly 20 years ago.

A Maine-born farm boy, he pyramided his first little Presque Isle sawmill into an electric power and railroad combine that powered and lighted Aroostook County and carried its products to market, and made him a millionaire in the process.

He served in the United States Senate from 1926 to 1931 after

Rockland, Nov. 13—Edward K. Gould, 74, prominent Rockland attorney, one of the three oldest members of the Knox County Bar and widely-known in Masonic fraternity of the State, died at his home tonight following a long illness.


Mr. Gould, a life-long resident of Rockland, had for many years been a leader in local and state affairs.

He has served as State Historian, had twice been Mayor of the city, had been chairman of the Republican county committee; judge of the Knox County Probate Court, commissioner of deeds when records of Knox, Waldo and Lincoln Counties were revised; was director of National Archives Research for Maine, New Hampshire and Vermont since the beginning of this work in 1937, and had also served as county treasurer.

Augusta, July 18—(AP)—John R. Gould, 78, who retired in 1931 after 44 years of continuous service in Augusta banking institutions died here today in the Augusta General Hospital of which he was president.
