FREEPORT - John Thomas Gould, the subject of this exegesis, was born at Brighton, Mass., part of the City of Boston, on the 22nd of October 1908. His father was a Maine farm boy, born at Lisbon, Androscoggin County, on Oct. 8, 1878, to Thomas Jordan and Hannah Foster Gould, she a schoolteacher and he a farmer and Civil War veteran. Franklin Farrar Gould, John's father, was named for Frank Farrar, a tent mate of Thomas in Company I of the 16, Maine Volunteers, a regiment that was active at Gettysburg and other places. Tom and Hannah had eight children. John's mother was Hilda Dobson Jenkins, born Dec. 14, 1886, daughter of John Henry and Catherine MacLeod Jenkins of Vernon River, Lot 50, on Prince Edward Island, Canada. Frank had left home at the age of 15, quitting school, had come to Boston to seek his fortune, and was a conductor on the surface cars of the Boston Elevated Railway. Hilda, half Scottish, was as pretty as a field of Highland heather, and had come to Boston as many Down East lassies did in those days, to seek a husband. Frank was the lucky one. The couple lived in a three-decker apartment house on Champney Street, just upgrade from Oak Square, until John was born, and then moved to suburban Medford, first to a 'flat' and then to a single house with a double lot at 28 Grant Avenue. Here Frank had land enough for a garden and a stable for hens, rabbits, and pigeons. The neighborhood was mostly immigrant Belgian, and the Belgians ate rabbits and raced homing pigeons. The hens and eggs were the assertion of a homesick Maine boy in a far place. Frank studied by mail and passed the examination for a railway postal clerk. In 1916 he was appointed such, and for the next forty-odd years 'ran' on the Vanceboro and Boston Railway Post Office. His job began and ended, east and west, at Portland, so he found a place he could buy, mortgage and all, at Freeport. In May of 1918 he moved from Massachusetts to Maine. By that time John was ten and had a sister Louise and a brother Franklin, Junior, both born in Medford. The fourth child of Frank and Hilda was being readied, and Sister Kathryn MacLeod was born in Freeport, August 24, 1918. As a railway postal clerk, Frank worked 'six and eight,' meaning that in six days on the train he worked the equivalent of two weeks time. Accordingly he had eight days for 'rest, study, and relaxation' after each tour on the road. This may sound like an occupational

Lt. Rene A. Goupil head of State Police Academy

WATERVILLE (AP) — Lt. Rene A. Goupil of West Buxton, commander of the Maine State Police Academy, suffered a fatal heart attack after completing his daily 2-mile run, state police said Wednesday, 1-29-90



Goupil, a 43-year-old ex-Marine who had headed the Waterville academy since October 1987, died Tuesday afternoon at Mid-Maine Medical Center.

Stephen McCausland, spokesman for the state Department of Public Safety, said an autopsy Wednesday determined that Goupil died of a heart attack.

McCausland said Goupil was stricken at the indoor track at Colby College after completing the exercise run that was part of his daily schedule.

Goupil, a Saco native, received bachelor's and master's degrees from the University of Southern Maine. He joined the Maine State Police in 1970 and was a patrol supervisor in Scarborough just prior to his promotion to lieutenant.

In 1989, he graduated from the FBI National Academy in Quantico, Va.

He was born in Biddeford, a son of Paul and Jeannette Pomerleau Goupil and graduated from Thornton Academy, Saco, in 1965.

He was a member of St. Ann's Church, Gorham, where he served as a eucharistic minister. He was a past member of the parish council.

He was a veteran of the U.S. Marine Corps.

He was a member of the Masons, and past master of the Buxton Lodge. He was a state coordinator for the Cystic Fibrosis Fund for the Maine State Police.

He is survived by his wife, Norma McAuley Goupil of Standish; a son, Eric N. Goupil of Los Angeles, Calif.; a daughter, Allison K. Goupil of Standish; and two sisters, Anthony (Pauline) Gordon of Saco, and Bertram (Nancy) Harriman of East Waterboro.


