# Charles G. Gowen, 80, Dies At Sanford

**Lifelong Resident Of Mill  
Town Formerly Goodall  
Company Overseer**

Sanford, Sept. 17—Charles G. Gowen, Sr., 80, for 38 years boss weaver for the Goodall Worsted Company and 18 years filling a similar position for the Sanford Mills, died today at his home, 53 Pleasant Street, Springvale, following a long illness. He was a native of this town, the son of George W. and Emily Cheney Gowen, and had always been a resident of this town, with the exception of five years when he was a weaver in the mills at Stamford, Conn. He married Susie Ridley of Sanford, who died in 1913.

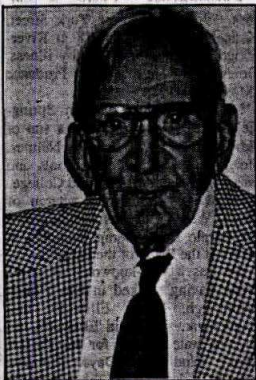

In 1947, he was playing for the Limington semi-pro team when he hit a home run in the final game of the season. "It was the only home run he ever hit in his life," said Alan Graffam, a son. That feat sent his team to Wichita, Kan., for the semi-pro World Series.

Mr. Graffam also played semi-pro basketball for some time.

Later, he coached basketball and baseball for many years, including basketball at Limington Academy in 1949 and 1950. He was active in semi-pro baseball and coached all levels of baseball, including Little League, Babe Ruth and American Legion.

"He was very much a teacher — of the game of baseball in particular," said Scott Graffam, a son. He encouraged all four of his children to play sports, and his sons James and Scott have taken up coaching as well.

Mr. Graffam was known as a practical joker. "He'd do things like send someone a letter that he'd say was from someone else — just to get a rise out of him."

His friends responded in kind, his sons said. "If somebody got mad, they humbly accepted it and swore to get back at him," said Scott Graffam.

He also enjoyed spending time with his six grandchildren, who range in age from 10 to 28 years old. "He kind of had a chance to spend time with all of them at different (ages)," Alan Graffam said.

He was born in Standish, a son of Darius and Florence Hoyt Graffam. He was the youngest of 10 children. He attended Standish High School.

He married Lois Boulter Graffam on March 18, 1944.

Mr. Graffam served in the Merchant Marine during World War II.

He operated Graffam Rentals, a skirting contractor, for Harold C. Ralph Mobile Homes in Waldo-boro for more than 20 years. He and his wife moved to Waldo-boro in 1956. He was a charter member of the Medomak Valley Boosters Club. He was an enthusiastic golfer and member of the Rockland Golf Club. He also was a Mason and member of the Rockland Elks Club.

ROCKPORT – E. Maynard "Sandy" Graffam Jr., 57, a well-known businessman and civic leader here, died at his home Thursday of cancer.

## E. Murray Graham
