Philip A. Graham

NEWBURY — Former longtime state senator and two-time gubernatorial candidate Philip A. Graham, 83, of 23 Old Rowley Road, died in his sleep on Nov. 1, 1993. He was the husband of Thelma Hyatt Graham of Newbury.

Mr. Graham was elected to the Massachusetts Senate several times, serving from 1951 until 1964. He was the Republican floor leader during his last three years in the senate.

Twice he made an unsuccessful bid for the Republican nomination for governor. After leaving elected office, he served as a commissioner on the Massachusetts Turnpike Authority from 1966 until 1973.

After serving in the Navy during World War II, Mr. Graham began his political career on the Swampscott School Committee.

Mr. Graham was an outspoken defender of causes he believed in. In the Senate he was referred to as Turkey Graham — a reference to the turkey farm that he and his wife owned in Hamilton.

Most recently, he resigned from the Republican party in protest over Governor Weld's acceptance of gambling in the Commonwealth.

He would like to be remembered by the following quote: "I fought the tigers, ... I was nibbled on by fleas. ... What bothered me most was the voters' apathy."

Although he had suffered a heart attack and a stroke in the past, he has enjoyed good health over recent years. He was born in Lynn on May 21, 1910 and grew up in Swampscott and Liniken Bay, Maine.
